

 - Quick and efficient transitions
 - Keep up with their own materials
 - Work with a partner or in a group

Writer's Workshop

- 10-15 minute mini lesson
- Independent writing time
- Author's chair
- Expectations
 - Write independently for the allotted time
 - Writing pieces are ongoing
 - Use rubrics and checklist to edit and revise
