In circumstances when parents need assistance in their heritage language, the school will provide information and documentation in the heritage language unless clearly not feasible. On the HLS, parents indicate which language they would prefer to receive communication in. The school will make an attempt to provide the parent with interpretive services for assistance unless clearly not feasible.

If a parent is in need of language assistance, the school contacts the ESOL contact person, who in turn will procure an interpreter for the school.

Documentation on how to read and interpret student report cards will be translated in Spanish for parents of ELL students. A sample report card will be provided as well so that parents will know what to expect.

This information will be sent to parents each nine week period when all students receive their report cards.
