

2023 Sequoyah High School Guidelines for Graduation Practices and Ceremony



Graduation from high school is an event that comes only once in a lifetime. Your parents, relatives, friends, and, most importantly, you, deserve a graduation ceremony that will be dignified and memorable. Your cooperation is essential. The following guidelines explain what is expected of you.

Chiefs 2023 Remind101 Group

Sign up for important updates and reminders regarding all Senior activities, including graduation, through the Remind101 communication platform. More information regarding how to sign up is located on the <u>Senior Information</u> page of Sequoyah High School's website.

Ceremony Participation Requirements

- Seniors must complete all course work (make-up tests, finals, etc.) by <u>Wednesday, May 17th at 3:15pm</u> and satisfy graduation requirements by this time in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Seniors must clear all outstanding debts by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 17th at 3:15pm</u> in order to receive your diploma.

Graduate Name Pronunciation

Graduates participating in the Graduation Ceremony are asked to complete a survey regarding the pronunciation of their full name. This information must be completed by Friday, March 31st using your CCSD account. This link is located on the <u>Senior Information</u> page of Sequoyah High School's website. You may also scan the QR Code to the right to access the survey.



General Graduation Ceremony Information

- Sequoyah High School's graduation ceremony is Friday, May 26th at 4:00pm at First Baptist Church of Woodstock (11905 Hwy 92, Woodstock, GA 30188).
- Graduates are to report to the Chapel by 2:30pm.
- All parents and guests must enter through the main entrance to the Worship Center. Doors for the general public will open at 3:00pm. Parents and guests will not be allowed in prior to 3:00pm.
- The graduation ceremony may be viewed LIVE on the internet at www.fbcw.org.
- Students will turn off Neese Road and park in front of Building A.
- Parents and guests will use the main entrance off of Highway 92 or Trickum Road and park in the designated area for parents and guests. Handicap parking is available.

Practice Guidelines/Information

- Seniors participating in the ceremony, including those that attended alternative high schools, <u>MUST</u> be present at the ENTIRE graduation practice the morning of Thursday, May 25th (tentatively from 8:00am 10:00am). DO NOT BE TARDY! Failure to attend this practice will result in not being able to participate in the graduation ceremony. Adjust your plans now so that you can be at practice.
- All CCSD Rules and Regulations are to be followed. This includes CCSD dress code.
- Any breaking of school rules during practice will result in student not participating in the graduation ceremony.
- No food or drink is allowed.
- Transportation to and from all practices is the responsibility of the student/parent.
- Students will be receiving several items at the practice such as the student's cumulative file, honor cords, graduation programs, diploma, and other misc. items. If the student is not participating in the ceremony, these items may be picked up during normal business hours beginning Tuesday, May 30th.

Graduation Ceremony Guidelines

- All CCSD Rules and Regulations are to be followed.
- The graduation ceremony is a privilege **not a right**. Any behavior which draws attention to you as an individual or detracts from the dignity of the ceremony itself will result in your removal from the ceremony and a record of the incident will be recorded on his/her permanent record.
- No items, except for the cap/gown are to be brought to the graduation ceremony by the graduate. These include but are not limited to: hangers, cell phones, purses, bags, cigarette lighters, vapes, etc.
- Attire:
 - Senior males should wear dark pants, white shirt, black dress shoes, and dark socks.
 - Senior females should wear dark dress (if the dress does not show below the gown, any color will be OK) and black dress shoes, low heels are recommended.
 - Not permitted are shorts, jeans, t-shirts, flip flops, tennis shoes, extremely informal attire inappropriate
 for the occasion, or any decoration or deviation from the traditional cap and gown, which would draw
 undue attention to the individual.
 - Only approved academic regalia allowed: honor chords, tassels, medallions, etc.
 - The administration in charge has the final decision in denying a graduate's participation due to inappropriate attire.
- Decoration to graduation caps is prohibited. Students violating this rule will have to purchase a new cap at the graduation ceremony.
- Graduation caps are not thrown in the air inside the facility. After the recessional, everyone will go out in front and caps will be thrown at that time.
- Spectators should remain in their seats during the ceremony. No one is allowed to move up front or into aisles to take pictures of their graduates.
- Absolutely no food or drink, noisemakers, balloons, or signs will be allowed inside First Baptist Church of Woodstock (FBCW). These will be confiscated by security.
- Please pre-arrange with your family a meeting place for after the ceremony.

Students Not Participating in the Graduation Ceremony

Any student not participating in Sequoyah's Graduation Ceremony is responsible for a diploma fee of \$30.00, which must be paid directly to Herff Jones. Diplomas are available for pick up from Student Services beginning Tuesday, May 30, 2023. Graduates must bring a copy of their receipt from Herff Jones when picking up their diploma. Diplomas will NOT be mailed.

Graduation Gowns

As you are preparing for graduation, please take a moment to make sure that you & your gown are ready for the big day!

- Any student participating in the graduation ceremony is required to order a cap and gown from ATL Grad. All information is found on their website at www.atlgrad.com. The graduation gown is a unique gown manufactured specifically for Sequoyah graduates which includes the Sequoyah Chief logo. No other gown is permitted.
- Students do not return their graduation cap or gown. They are both for the student to keep as a souvenir.
- Upon receiving your cap and gown, immediately take it out of the bag and hang it on a hanger. There is no need to wash the gown as your gown is delivered properly cleaned. If necessary, only steam the gown DO NOT IRON.
- If your cap or gown does not fit, please contact ATL Grad directly at 770-795-1626. There will also be a representative available on the day of graduation for any last-minute problems. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT until then if you know there is a problem today!

- Students/parents will receive an email within 48 72 hours of Graduation with a link to view the graduation images.

- Please allow 2-3 weeks for delivery.

Family and friends are asked not to leave their seats to take photographs during the ceremony.

Final Transcripts

To send your Final Transcript to the college of your choice you will use GA Futures or Parchment. Set up your free account with both. You will be able to send your final transcript to any college in Georgia through GA Futures for free. You can go to Sequoyah's website and click on the Request Transcript button. Set up your free Parchment account and send your transcript anywhere in state or out of state for a \$5.90 fee. Both links are listed below.

All final transcripts will be uploaded to both GA Futures and Parchment by the end of June, if there are no complications. As soon as they are uploaded, an email will be sent to all graduates. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SEND A FINAL TRANSCRIPT UNTIL AFTER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THIS EMAIL.** If you do not wait, you will only be sending transcripts that were uploaded in January.




Sequoyah High School will not be providing transportation to the elementary schools. More details about participation will be communicated through Remind101. Please contact the elementary school you attended if you have any questions.
