# SENIOR PROJECT - WHAT IS IT?

- ✗ A four-week project outside the building  
( Monday, April 18th - Friday, May 13)
- ✗ Replaces some or all of your school day  
(more on this later...)
- ✗ You design the project, subject to our approval





# SENIOR PROJECT - WHAT IS IT?

- ✗ Report to your project location instead of school
- ✗ Five days a week, but doesn't need to be Mon- Fri
- ✗ 5 hours each day, but doesn't need to be the school day



# SENIOR PROJECT - MODIFIED

- ✗ If you have any of the following:
  - ✗ AP Classes
  - ✗ Project Lead the Way (PLTW)
  - ✗ Dance Lab I & II
  - ✗ Certain Music & Performing Arts
- ✗ Still attend the above classes
- ✗ Daily requirement on project is reduced to 2 ½ hours



# SENIOR PROJECT - PARTNER?

- x** Partner projects will be approved if there is a **legitimate** need for more than one person to complete the project





# SENIOR PROJECT - SAMPLE CAREER PROJECTS

- ✗ Teachers aide in a classroom (grade 1-8)
- ✗ Working in marketing/advertising
- ✗ Working at a law firm
- ✗ Working in an auto repair shop
- ✗ Computer Program/App Development
- ✗ Interning at a local radio or tv station
- ✗ Working in Medicine (physician, hospital, dentist, etc.)



# SENIOR PROJECT - SAMPLE CREATIVE PROJECTS

- ✗ Writing a novel/short stories/poetry
- ✗ Designing clothes
- ✗ studying /learning various musical instruments
- ✗ Writing a screenplay
- ✗ Writing and recording a multi song album
- ✗ Restoring an antique jukebox
- ✗ Designing and Building a drone
- ✗ Getting a pilot's license





# SENIOR PROJECT - SAMPLE SERVICE PROJECTS

- ✗ Volunteering at a non-profit/charity
- ✗ Animal shelter/animal training
- ✗ Working with environmental organizations
- ✗ Working in a government/political office

- ✘ Investigating the environmental impact of paper recycling techniques
- ✘ Exploring the history of Jazz
- ✘ Studying Infectious diseases at Northwestern University

  - ✗ You will work with them for 4 weeks



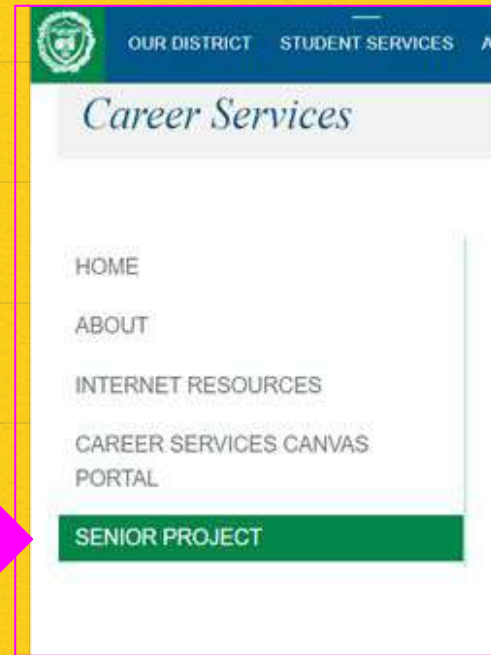


# SENIOR PROJECT - COVID?



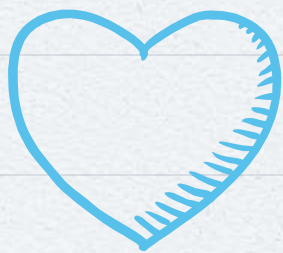
