We will have several makeup dates first semester, but please do not rely on these if at all possible. These are the pictures that go into the yearbook. You will take formal, Cap & Gown and pictures with 2 personal outfits of your choice. We have the tux, drapes and Caps/Gowns for these pictures. Boys need to wear a clean white t-shirt under their casual outfit and girls need to wear shirt (tank top is recommended) and bra that can be pulled off the shoulder for the drape shot.
