Purpose



 Provides a diploma option to students who pass an Industry Certification course and test leading to college credit.



Industry Certification

English – 4 credits

Math – 4 credits

English 1, 2, 3, 4 or higher

10th Grade Reading FCAT 2.0 – Level 3 or above Industry certification leading to college credit may replace 2 math credits excluding Algebra 1 and Geometry

Algebra 1 & Geometry EOC 30% of grade

Algebra 1 EOC level 3 or above

Four credits earned in 9th-12th grade



Industry Certification

Science – 4 credits

Social Studies – 3 credits

Industry certification leading to college credit may replace 1 science credit excluding Biology

Biology required EOC counts 30% of grade

Three credits must include a lab component



SCPS Scholars with Distinction

Students entering 9th grade in 2010-11

3.75 Cumulative Weighted GPA Three years/ consecutive levels in the same World Language

6 credits in AP or IB classes

- Earn A or B grades
- Two A or B Dual Enrollment credits may be applied to this requirement



SCPS Scholars with Distinction

 Meet all the requirements for Scholars Pathway Diploma

And

<u>OR</u>

 Complete 1 credit in Experimental Research or equivalent with an A or B Complete an Extended Essay, Senior Portfolio or Project or 4th year of same World Language

<u>OR</u>

=Scholar With Distinction

 1 extra AP, IB or Dual Enrollment credit beyond Scholars Pathway Diploma

Changes to End of Course Exams

EOC results no longer determine credit in a course

Starting in 13-14 all EOC results will be calculated as 30% of student's final grade
