What are we learning?

Language Arts:

Grammar: We will use our language arts instruction to complete The Great Mail Race letters we began last week.

Reading and Writing:

We will begin our student self-selected biography unit. Your child will be going to the library Tuesday to choose a biography for this project. We will dive into reading and writing about individuals that shaped our history. Please encourage your child to share with you daily about their chosen individual.

Social Studies:

We will continue studying the Native American Nez Perce and Hopi tribes. We will explore the differences in regions, resources, clothing, shelter, food, and customs.

Math:

This week we will be subtracting large numbers and continue our rounding unit. We will also begin incorporating word problems within our units of study.

Science:

Space/Solar System

This week we will begin our unit of the attributes of stars. In class, students will create a scaled model of four of the closest stars to Earth to explain how distance and size affect the appearance of stars.
