WELCOME!

- Introduction
- Exciting Times for the SFMS Band
- 2015-2016 will be my 3rd year at SFMS
- Very successful year in 2014-2015
- Band has grown from 130 in May of 2013 to 365 in 2015
- - 175 6th grade
 - 106 7th grade (87 in 2013)
 - 81 8th grade (there were 38 8th grade in 2013)

OVERVIEW OF OUR SUCCESS

- Straight Superior Ratings at GMEA LGPE for both Concert and Symphonic.
- Superior Rating by 6th grade at High Note Festival at Kell High School, with a perfect 100 from one judge.
- Superior Rating, Best in Class and Gold Award at Festival Disney
- 26 Students selected for GMEA Dist 9 HB
- 7 Student selected for GMEA All-State Band
- 148 Students participated in GMEA Solo and Ensemble, with 123 Superior ratings.

OVERVIEW OF OUR PERFORMANCES

- 6th Grade presented a concert in December and May and High Note Festival.
- 7th/8th Grade performed at: Fall Concert SFHS Cluster Concert, December Concert, Festival Disney, GMEA LGPE, and our Spring Concert.
- 8th Grade Band students performed at Fallapolooza
- 7th and 8th grade performed at Riverwatch FB
- Performed at two pep rallies.
- 7th grade band performed for recruiting visits.

HOW THE CLASSES ARE ORGANIZED

- - Students are grouped by their class next year.
 - On-level (Concert Band) and Accelerated (Symphonic Band)
 - Depending on other electives, some students may be placed in a different band class to accommodate the double class.
 - I spoke with these students today.
- All classes are year-long and meet as a daily connections class.
- Concert Band will have about 4-6 after school rehearsals. Symphonic Band will have 12-14 after school rehearsals.

7TH AND 8TH GRADE

- We will have two groups:
 - Accelerated=Symphonic Band
 - On-level=Concert Band
 - These groups will work like other Accel/OL classes
- Students have been placed into one of the two groups.
- All Symphonic Band students will audition for chair placements when we return in the fall.
- Concert Band students can also receive the summer packet and play for me again in the fall.
- Students falling short or exceling may have their schedule placement adjusted.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

Accelerated

- Students should be performing on an advanced 8th grade or higher level.
- Be willing to make a larger time commitment.
- More rehearsals and performances
- Will learn more music at a faster pace
- Will have additional expectations, such as All-State, Solo and Ensemble

On-level

- Will have fewer performances/after school rehearsals
- Will learn music at a normal rate.
- Will perform at FCCBF and LGPE
- Performance expectations are the same.
- Will perform on-level music for 7th and 8th grade.

EXPENSES FOR 7TH AND 8TH

- Same Polo shirts this year, only buy if you need one.
- Band fee will be \$50.
- We will work from two books: Foundations for Superior Performance and 101 Rhythmic Rest Patterns.
- Symphonic Band will have an additional concert attire. Returning members only need to purchase if needed. All new members must purchase.
- There will be a required trip for Symphonic to Athens and an optional trip for all 7th and 8th grade band students

CONCERT ATTIRE FOR SYM BAND

- Cost is \$75. We will allow you to sell to new students after you are done.
- Ladies=Black Concert Dress

 Gentlemen=Tuxedo Pants, Shirt, Blue Bowtie, Black Vest





FUNDRAISING

- Our one fundraiser is Rock-a-thon
- Will be in September.
- We collect pledges to rock in rocking chairs for 6 hours, play games, have fun and enjoy each other's company.
- We need to raise a lot of money.
- We need about \$18,000 in new instruments b/c we are growing so fast.
- I will need to form a parent committee for this. Let me know if you can help. Looking for a chair person.
- We may have to do more fundraising if we do not meet our goal. WE NEED A LOT OF EQUIPMENT and INSTRUMENTS!

OUR TRIP IS TO?

YES! BACK TO DISNEY BUT WITH A TWIST!

- The band, along with the chorus program, will be taking a trip back to Disney this coming spring.
- Open to all 7th and 8th grade students. Trip is optional but we must meet a minimum number.
- We will travel to Orlando by luxury charter buses to Walt Disney World. March 10-13, 2015. Different plant.
- We will stay on property, like last year.
- We will perform at Disney in their educational workshop program with Disney musicians.
- Visit three days of Disney Parks
- Have a lot of fun!
- Cost will be approximately \$600.
- There will be a limit of 94 students and 16 chaperones or until we reach 3 full charter buses combined with the chorus.

TRIP DETAILS

- Payments will begin in September after
 Symphonic Band auditions are completed.
- Final payment will be in January.
- We will leave Thursday, March 10, early and arrive later that day.
- Visit parks on March 10, 11 and 12. and complete the workshop at some point during that time.
- Come home on Sunday.

SCHOOL-OWNED INSTRUMENTS

- Instruments that are not being repaired can be rechecked out on Thursday.
- For all other school-owned instruments, I will send out an email once I receive the instruments back from the shop.
- I will set-up a couple of different days for students to come and check-out an instrument.
