Who can become a WatchDOG at Sharon Elementary?

How long is a WatchDOG day?

The day begins at 7:00 am and lasts until approximately 1:00 pm.

How many days does a WatchDOG volunteer?

WatchDOGS are asked to volunteer at least one day throughout the school year but are encouraged to come as often as they are able.

Do I have to buy a WatchDOG shirt?

Yes, a WatchDOG Shirt is a required uniform to be worn during your volunteer day(s). Any additional WatchDOG items are optional.

How do I order a WatchDOG shirt?

How much do shirts cost?

Shirts cost \$10.00. "WatchDOGS ROCK" shirts are also available for moms to purchase for \$10.00.

What do WatchDOGS do at Sharon?

On your volunteer day you will receive a structured schedule to follow throughout your day. You will receive a brief orientation when you arrive.

What does a typical WatchDOG schedule look like?

Typically you will:

- Assist with car duty or bus duty in the morning •
- Volunteer in several classrooms throughout the day
- Patrol the hallways
- Monitor the lunchroom
- Patrol recess

Will I see my student(s) throughout the day?

- You will be volunteering in your student(s) classroom at least one time during the day
- You will be schedule to have lunch with at least one of your students
