### Where to Find and How to Access Most of the Literature Resources in the SHS Media Center

Go to the **Destiny Catalog Page**, type the author's name, and click Keyword. The result is a list of all books **by** and **about** the author. For criticism only, type the author's name and the word **criticism** (example: **Emily Dickinson criticism**), and click Keyword. This "Results list" contains critical essays **about** the author.
