Go to the **SHS Media Catalog (Destiny) Catalog Page**, type the author's name, and click Keyword. This displays a list of all books **by** and **about** the author. For criticism only, type the author's name and the word **criticism** (example: **Emily Dickinson criticism**), and click Keyword. This displays a list of books that contain critical essays **about** the author.
