

# Significant Disproportionality in I-Star

ISBE has developed an interactive tool to view Significant Disproportionality data in the IWAS application, I-Star. Districts can view data from multiple school years and track risk ratios for Identification, Discipline, and Placement.

\* After logging in, all District Administrators will see the new button on the landing page in I-Star.

\* Click the button to view the application in a new tab — if the district has a determination, it will populate on the initial tab. Even districts without a determination can view the data
