Sunlake High School Pathways Explanations

Traditional – After high school, this student will enter the work force, join the military, or attend a technical or community college. College Prep – After high school, this student will attend a community college or four-year university (with the foreign language requirement completed). Advanced College Prep – After high school, this student will attend a more competitive four-year university (with the foreign language requirement completed). Advanced Coursework Expectations

AP Exam Requirements - AP courses are designed for students to achieve college credit. Students are required to take the AP exam in May. Separate AP Agreement required.

Dual Enrollment - Separate application required. An un-weighted cumulative 3.0 GPA and appropriate ACT, SAT, or PERT score are required. All requirements for DE Enrollment must be met no later than May 16, 2014.

In order to be complete the registration process for the 2014-2015 school year, all current students must meet criteria and have paperwork returned by May 16, 2014. Students not meeting this deadline will have their courses chosen for them and will not be permitted to make changes.
