About the Art Program

Large projects are graded by a set of rubrics, and students have the time to reflect and revise to do their best.

Students are learning about the Elements of Art and Principles of Design, and will use this vocabulary to learn how to discuss, describe and critique art. This is a great way to learn about art and strengthen literacy skills. This work is mostly done in class. If students need extra time at home to write, it can be brought in the next day.
