#### **Course Description:**

This course is intended to provide a rigorous training of dance in a broad sense, covering technical aspects of Ballet, Jazz, and Modern dance. Time will also be spent on development of kinesthetic awareness, anatomy, fitness, and dance history.

#### **Supplies Needed**

- ~Spiral Notebook (to be used exclusively for dance class)
- ~Tan Jazz Shoes (see attached sheet for more info) \*Must have shoes by Monday Aug. 31st, 2015
- ~Dance Clothing- Loose knit clothing that you can easily move in. Examples are t-shirts, sweat pants, leggings, athletic shorts and pants, or dance apparel such as leotards and tights. \*NO Skirts, Dresses or Jeans.
- ~Clear bottle for water ONLY; Must have a cap/top to bottle. \*Students will not be permitted to leave class to go to the water fountain.

#### **Course Expectations:**

You are expected to dress out everyday no matter what. If you are ill, you must have a signed Parent or Doctor's note to excuse you from dancing. Otherwise, you will be sent to the nurse's office or given a zero for the day. Participation is a must in a dance class. Your final exam will be an after school performance at the end of the semester, which contributes to 30% of your grade. Only parents/guardians can communicate a student not being able to attend the concert, and an alternative written assignment will be given to those students. You will be graded on a daily basis as to how much and how well you participate. Always try your best, have a positive attitude, complete your written work on time, and you will succeed!!
