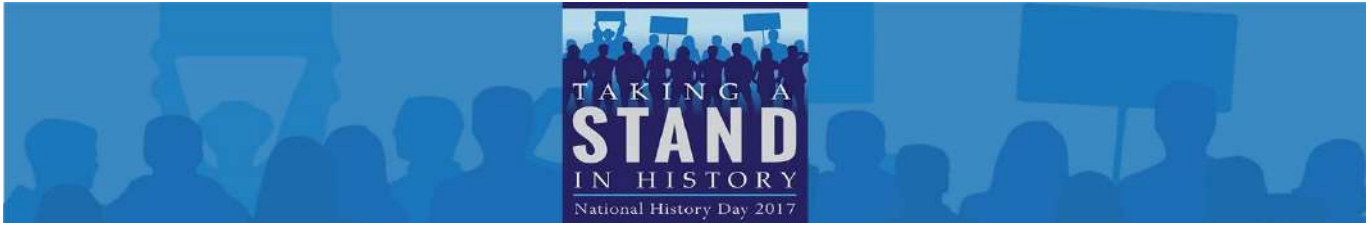


SOCIAL STUDIES PARENT NIGHT
