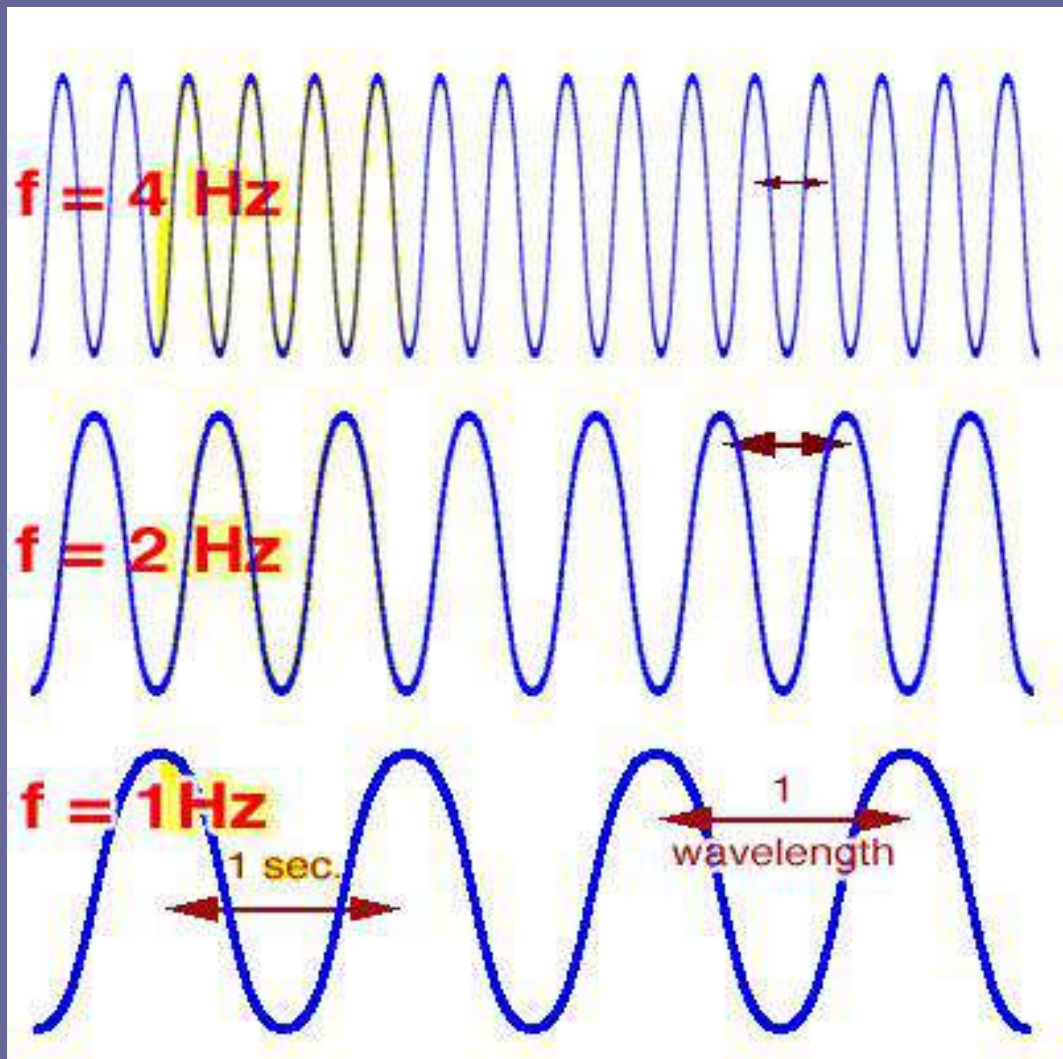

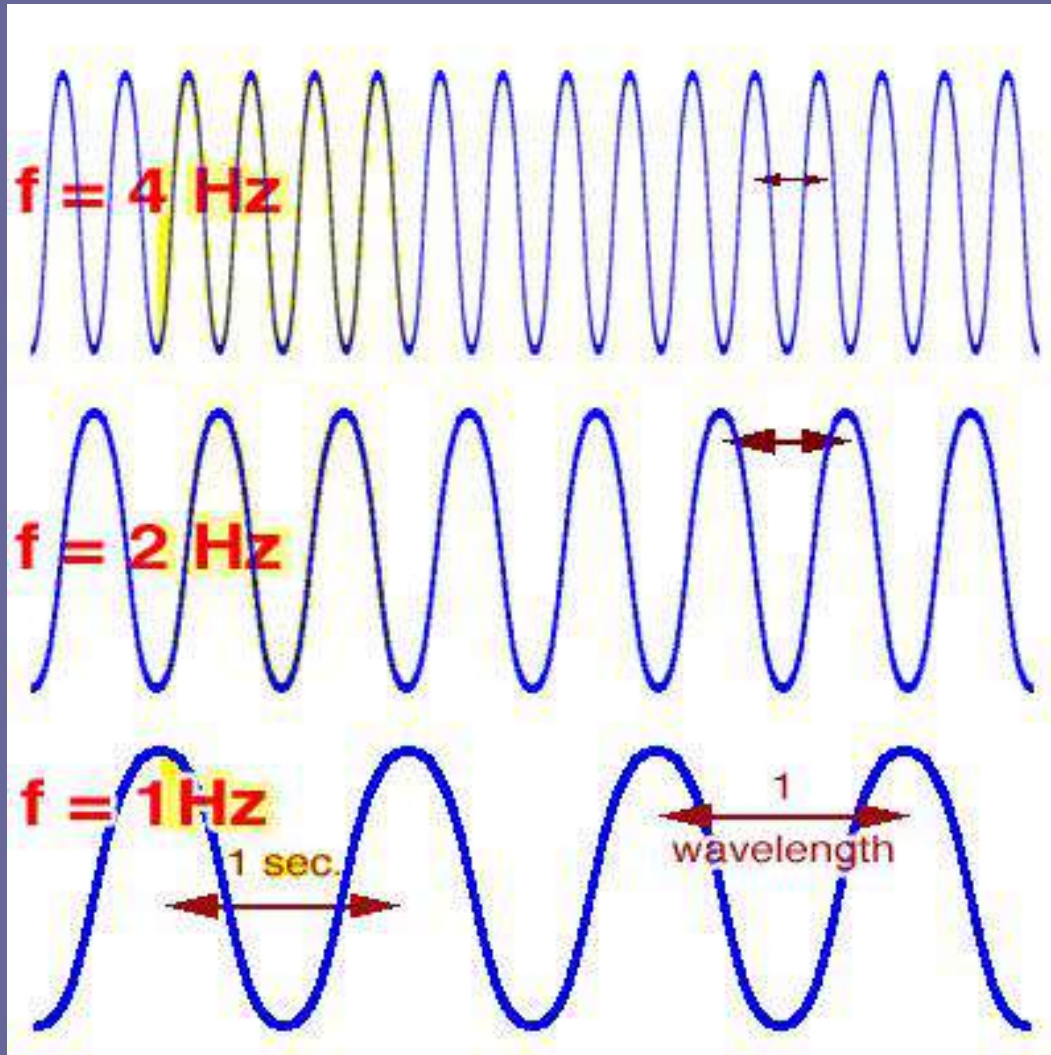

Translucent



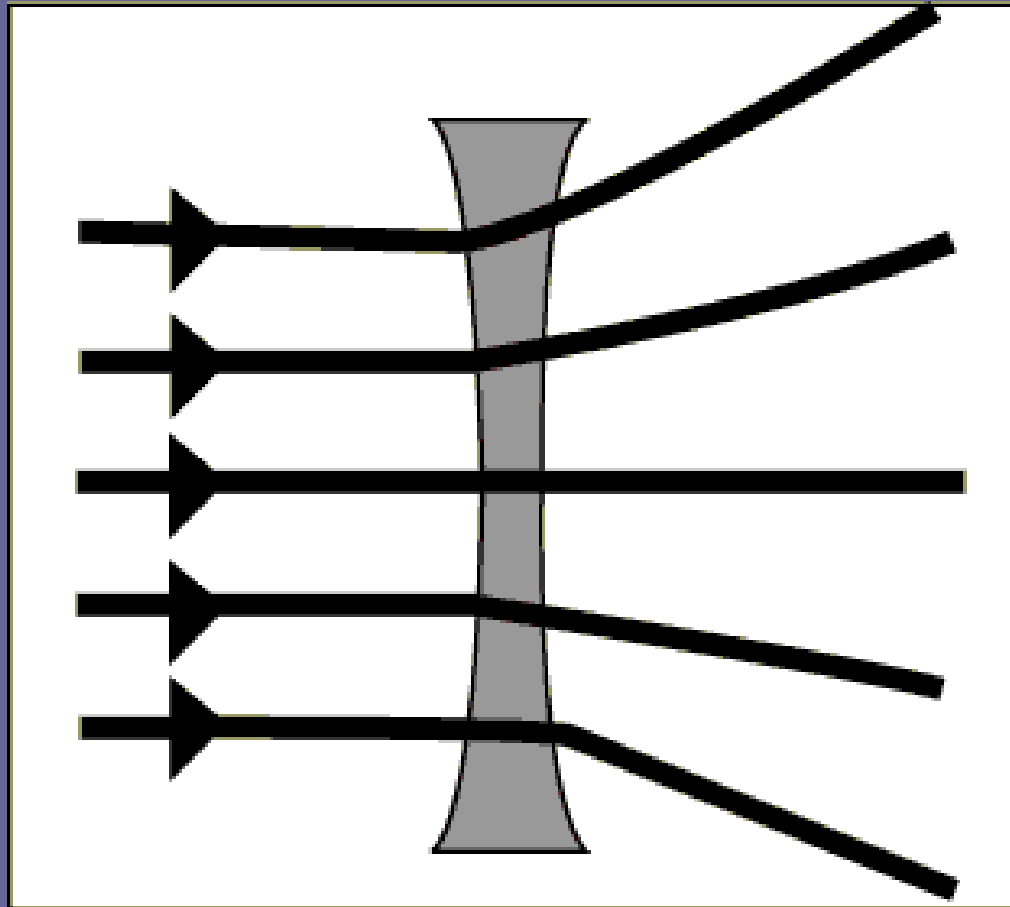

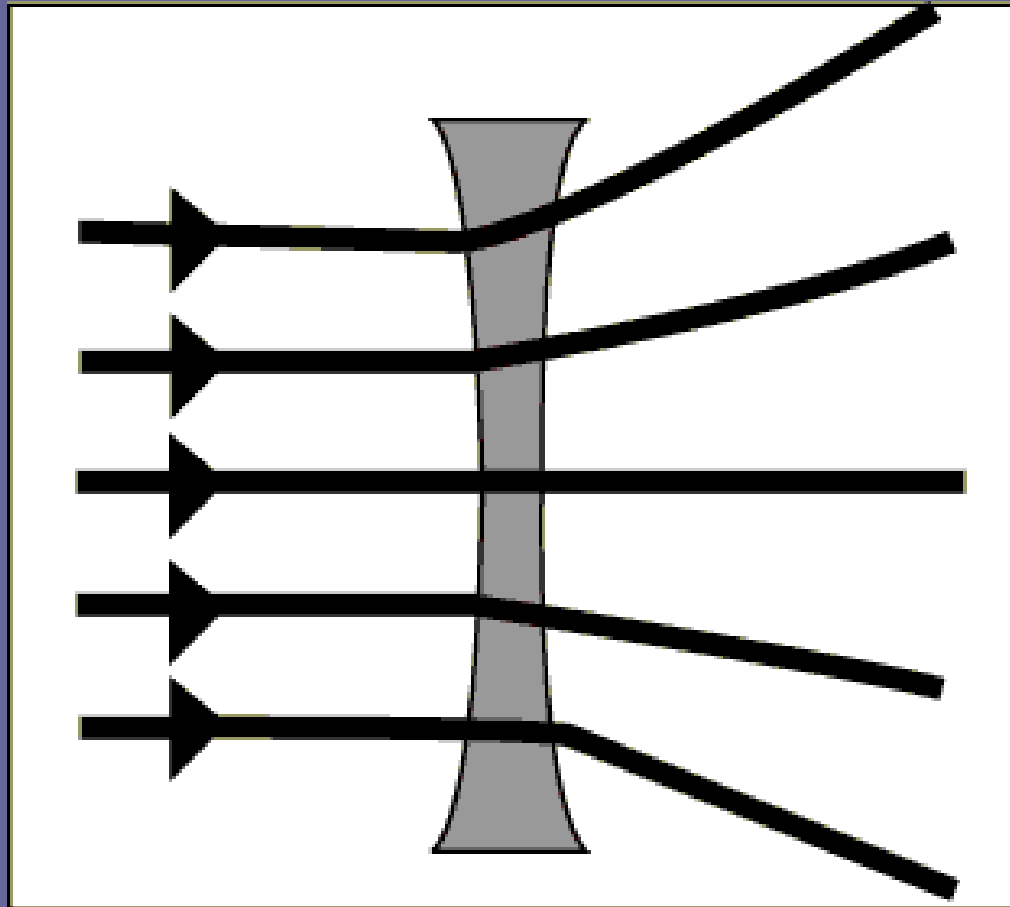

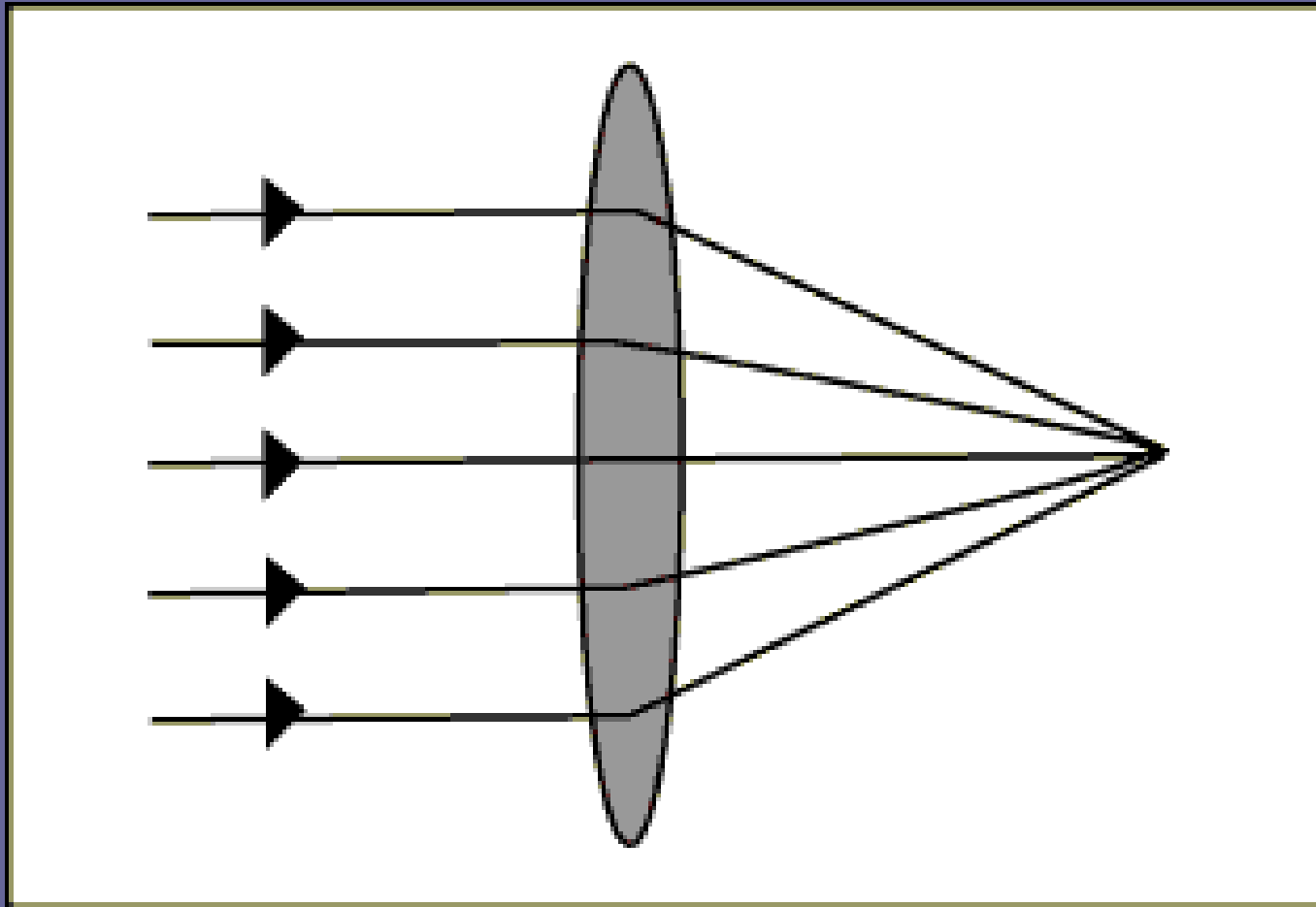
What do we call a lens that is thicker at the edges than in the middle?
