You will need to use the future tense in this paragraph. Be creative.

Describe what happened and how the story ended. Be sure you use at least 5-6 complete Spanish sentences in your response.

You will be using the present tense, preterite, and imperfect tenses in this paragraph. Be sure to add lots of details.

Your boyfriend/girlfriend wants to buy you something for your birthday. What do you want him/her to buy you? What do you not want him/her to buy you? Give reasons to support your choices. Be sure you use at least 5-6 complete Spanish sentences in your response.

Be specific and descriptive.

Poverty is a social problem that affects every nation in the world. What are your suggestions and ideas as to how to help people overcome poverty? Be sure you use at least 5-8 complete Spanish sentences in your response.
