Audition Packet 2015-2016 Season



Welcome to the 2015-2016 Switzerland Point Winterguard Audition Process. Please read through the entire packet to get information about auditions and requirements for each student.

Audition Dates, Attire, and Location

Audition training days will be May 11th from 4:00-6:00 PM and May 12th - May 14th ,2015 from 4:00 to 6:30pm. Students need to wear comfortable black shorts, black t-shirt, and report to the SPMS gym. Please bring a snack and a drink (Your drink MUST have a lid). No friends or family will be permitted in the gym during auditions; this is a closed audition process.

Experience and Achievements

Winterguard is an exciting activity that gives students the opportunity to meet new friends, learn a new skill, travel to competitions, and perform in front of crowds many times. During the past eight years of competition the Switzerland Point Winterguard has brought home 4 Gold Medals, 4 Silver Medals, and 1 Bronze Medal from the Florida Federation of Colorguards Circuit. This is the highest honor a middle school team can achieve.

Time Requirements

The SPMS Winterguard will practice on a weekly basis during the school year, with the possibility of additional volunteer practices during the spring competitive season. Weekly practices will be set before the 2015-2016 school year begins, but are currently set on Wednesday afternoons, from 1-5:30pm.

August to December is used to write and design the show. January through March is the performance season. During the performance season there will be between 6-9 shows. They will always be on Saturdays, with the exception of Pre-Premier, the date of which will be decided closer to the beginning of the competition season. It is very important for guard members to be at every practice and EVERY SHOW. Shows are performed all throughout the State of Florida. Shows can last from 9:00 am to well into the late afternoon, so prepare for an all-day event. We require that all students remain at the show until awards are given for our class category.

Financial Requirements

As with any activity, Winterguard requires a certain amount of financial responsibility. Each member will have a "fair share" of the budget that he/she is responsible to uphold. Please plan for a fair share of approximately \$600-\$650 per child, as well as, travel expenses and incidentals. More details will be handed out to SPMS guard members after tryouts.

Academic / Behavior Requirements

Switzerland Point requires that our members maintain a minimum 70% in all classes, display a positive attitude, and model positive behavior at all times. Grade and behavior reports will be required throughout the school year to verify they are maintaining the academic and behavior requirements.

Attached are forms that must be completed and returned to Darlene Dowling (SPMS teacher sponsor) the first day of tryouts. If the forms are not completed, the student will not be able to participate in tryouts.
