** Info for AP and Dual Enrollment Students: Students enrolled in AP US History or Dual Enrollment US History <u>cannot</u> complete the US History EOC assessment. Students in AP American Lit or Dual Enrollment American Lit <u>must</u> take the EOC. Students in AP Biology or Dual Enrollment Biology will <u>only</u> take the EOC if they have <u>NOT</u> previously completed the core high school Biology course.

Spring 2022 Georgia Milestones Assessments

Students enrolled in **Algebra I**, **American Literature & Composition**, **Biology**, and **U.S. History** courses will report for testing on the days shown above. Both **face-to-face students** and **virtual-only students** are required to complete the EOC if they are enrolled in an EOC-affiliated course, and the EOC is required by state law to count as **20% of the final course average**.

Reporting to Campus for Testing

Our virtual students must report to campus to take an EOC as the state does not offer an online version that can be administered at home. Parents/Guardians of virtual students are responsible for providing transportation to and from the student's districted school for testing.

Virtual students taking an EOC will report to campus no later than 8:30 AM on their scheduled testing date. Students will be dropped off at the front of the school and enter the front office where they will then be shown to their testing location. Students planning to drive onto campus will park in the parking lot on top of the hill on the left-hand side once they enter campus. All testing sessions will end no later than 12:00 PM (there will be a few exceptions for students who have extended time accommodations through an IEP, 504, or TPC plan). If testing ends early, students will be able to contact their rides to be picked up earlier. All students will be picked up in front of the school.
