** Info for AP and Dual Enrollment Students: Students enrolled in AP US History or Dual Enrollment US History <u>cannot</u> complete the US History EOC assessment. Students in AP American Lit or Dual Enrollment American Lit <u>must</u> take the EOC. Students in AP Biology or Dual Enrollment Biology will <u>only</u> take the EOC if they have <u>NOT</u> previously completed the core high school Biology course. AM = Morning Session, PM = Afternoon Session.

Spring 2022 Georgia Milestones Assessments

Students enrolled in Algebra I, American Literature & Composition, Biology, and U.S. History courses will report for testing on the days shown above. Both face-to-face students and virtual-only students are required to complete the EOC if they are enrolled in an EOC-affiliated course, and the EOC is required by state law to count as 20% of the final course average.

Reporting to Campus for Testing

All virtual students must report to their designated campus to take an EOC as the state does not offer an online version that can be administered at home. Parents/Guardians of virtual students are responsible for providing transportation to and from the student's testing site.

Most virtual students will report to their home school to complete their EOC's. <u>However, all ALFAS students, all Phoenix</u> <u>students, and select PVA students will report to the New Hope Education Center to complete their EOC assessments</u>. PVA <u>students should confirm their EOC testing location with their virtual teachers prior to the schedule date of the EOC</u>. *The calendar shown above pertains only to those testing at NHEC*. *The testing schedule at each high school may differ*.

Students testing at the New Hope Education Center campus should report to Room 203 by 8:20 a.m. on the day of the EOC.
