** Info for AP and Dual Enrollment Students: Students enrolled in AP US History or Dual Enrollment US History <u>cannot</u> complete the US History EOC assessment. Students in AP American Lit or Dual Enrollment American Lit <u>must</u> take the EOC. Students in AP Biology or Dual Enrollment Biology will <u>only</u> take the EOC if they have <u>NOT</u> previously completed the core high school Biology course. AM = Morning Session, PM = Afternoon Session.

Spring 2022 Georgia Milestones Assessments

Students enrolled in **Algebra I**, **American Literature & Composition**, **Biology**, and **U.S. History** courses will report for testing on the days shown above. Both **face-to-face students and virtual-only students** are required to complete the EOC if they are enrolled in an EOC-affiliated course, and the EOC is required by state law to count as **20% of the final course average**.

Reporting to Campus for Testing

Our virtual students must report to campus to take an EOC as the state does not offer an online version that can be administered at home. Parents/Guardians of virtual students are responsible for providing transportation to and from the student's districted school for testing.

Virtual students are to report to the office in the front entrance of the school. Students will arrive by 8:20 am and be picked up by 11:00 am. Staff members will be available to assist students to the testing locations once they report to campus. Drop off and dismissal for virtual students will be located at the front of the school.
