**Description:** The Social Studies Task Force will be comprised of teacher-leaders representing each school in Griffin-Spalding County Schools. The purpose of the team is to empower teachers to serve as social studies instructional leaders in their buildings. Participation on this task force will provide selected teachers with an amazing opportunity to improve their content and pedagogical knowledge of social studies. With a specific focus on Engaging in Historical Inquiry, Connecting and Contextualizing, and Deciding and Acting, participants will receive training and materials that will allow teachers to enhance their own pedagogy as well as offer valuable leadership opportunities.

The program will consist of workshops and meetings both during and after the school day, some of which will be held offcontract time for which teachers will receive stipends. Because participants will work with administrators and building-level leadership to meet instructional needs in the area of social studies, teachers will be required to complete all assigned tasks, and attend all professional learning in order to be eligible.
