





### Atacama Desert


- Located between the Pacific Ocean and the Andes Mountains in northern Chile.
- It is the <u>driest place on earth!</u> (Has never rained in some places!) Largest supply of nitrates on earth. (the sand mummifies/ concrete-like.) =  $2^{nd}$  largest salt flats area in world.

- Starting in the Andes Mountains in Peru, the Amazon River flows east across South America through Brazil to the Atlantic Ocean. \*\*\*2<sup>nd</sup> Longest River in World.
- The world's largest tropical rain forest & 20+% of world's oxygen source.
- is home to the most isolated indigenous tribes in the world.
   (pure traditional econ.) There are at least 77 un-contacted groups in the region.








## Pacific Ocean
