- Europe is part of a large landmass called Eurasia.

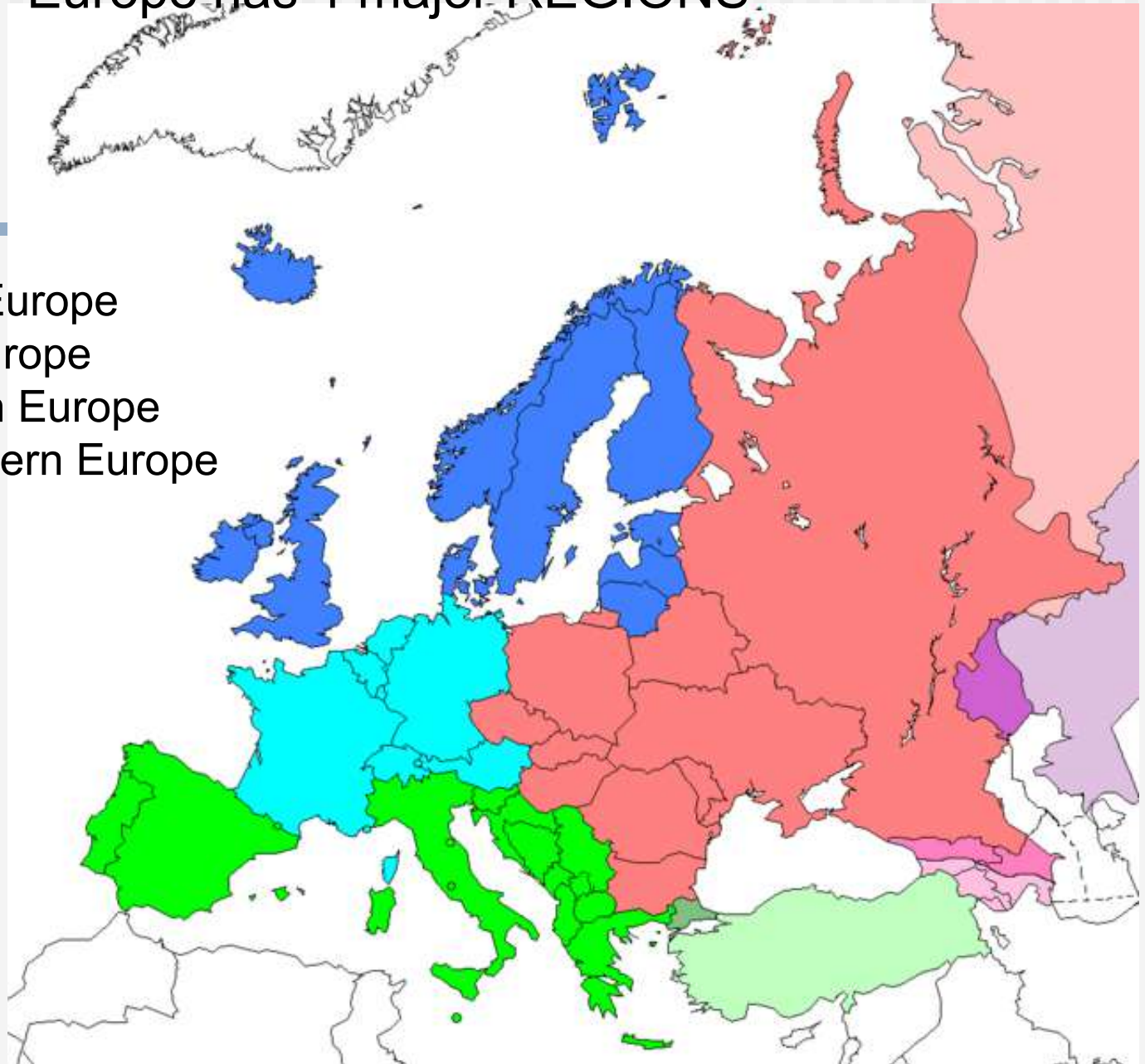
# The Land

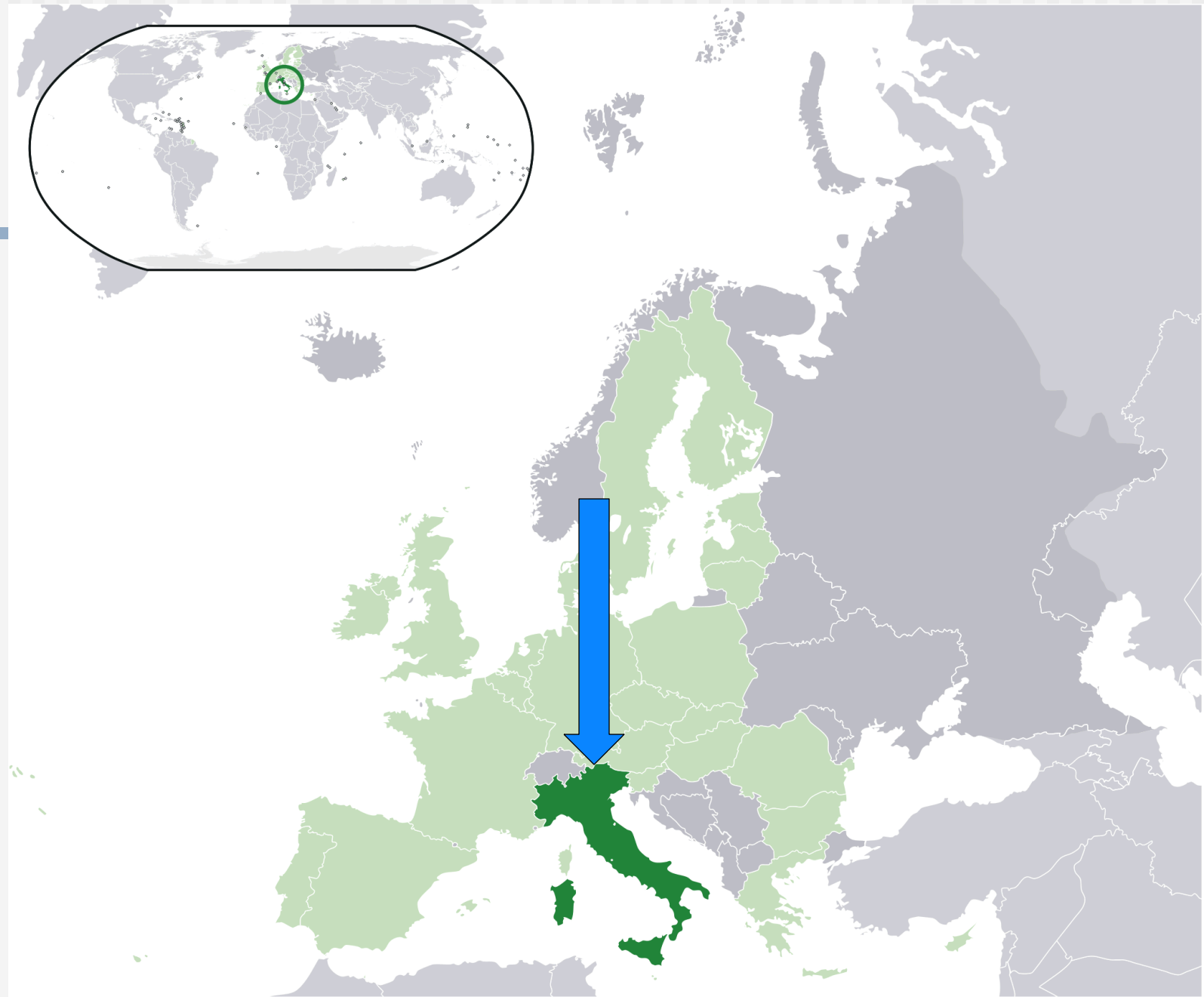


# The Italian Peninsula

- Language = Italian







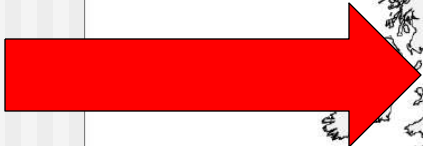
# United Kingdom

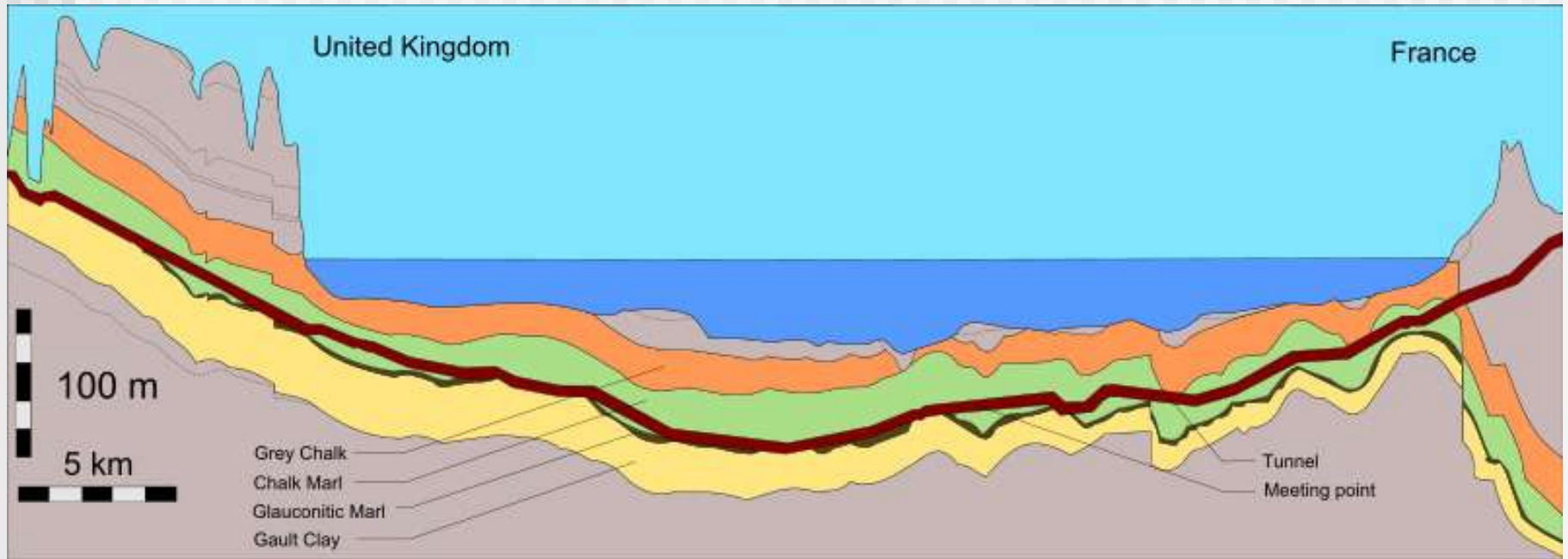

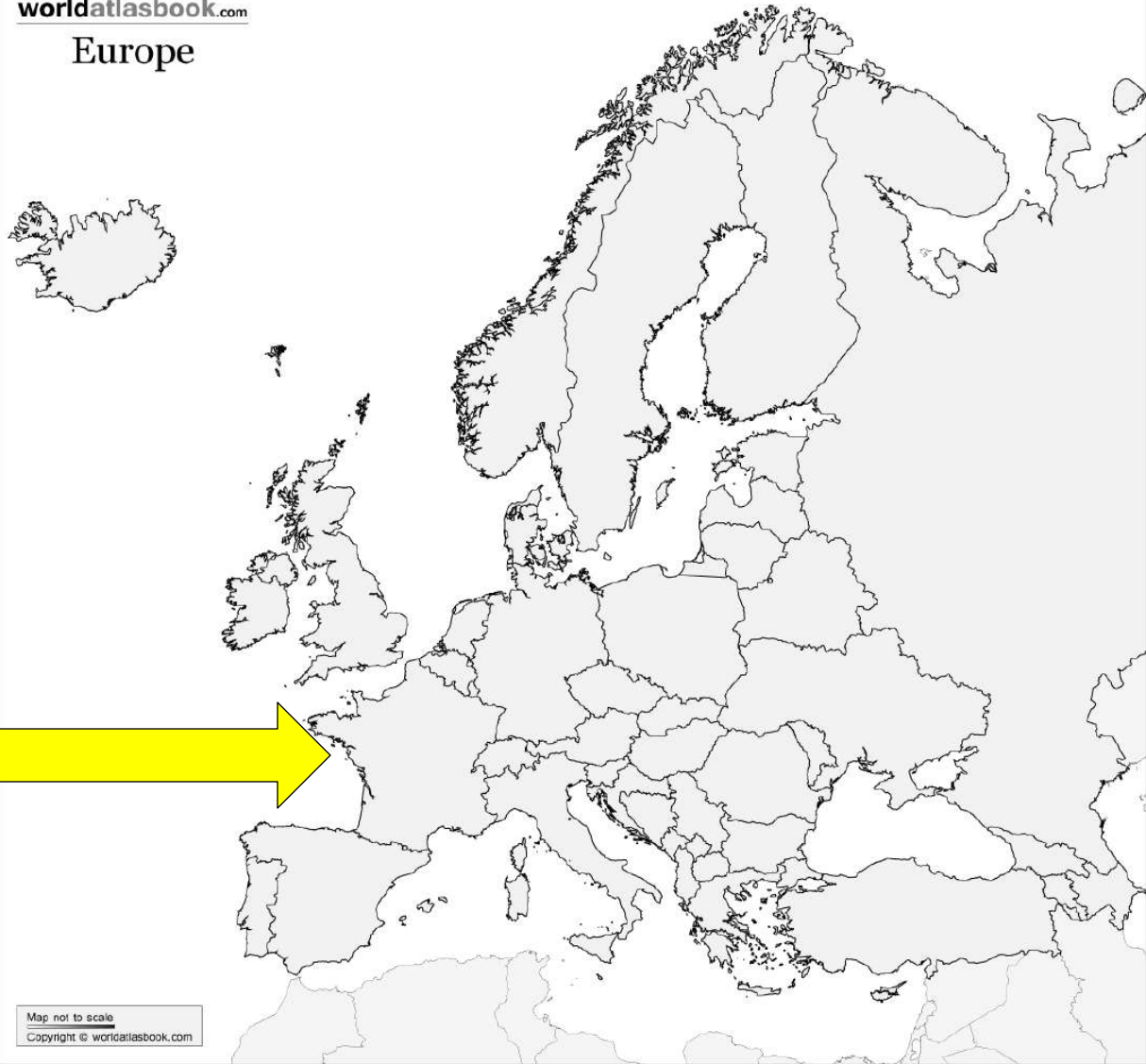

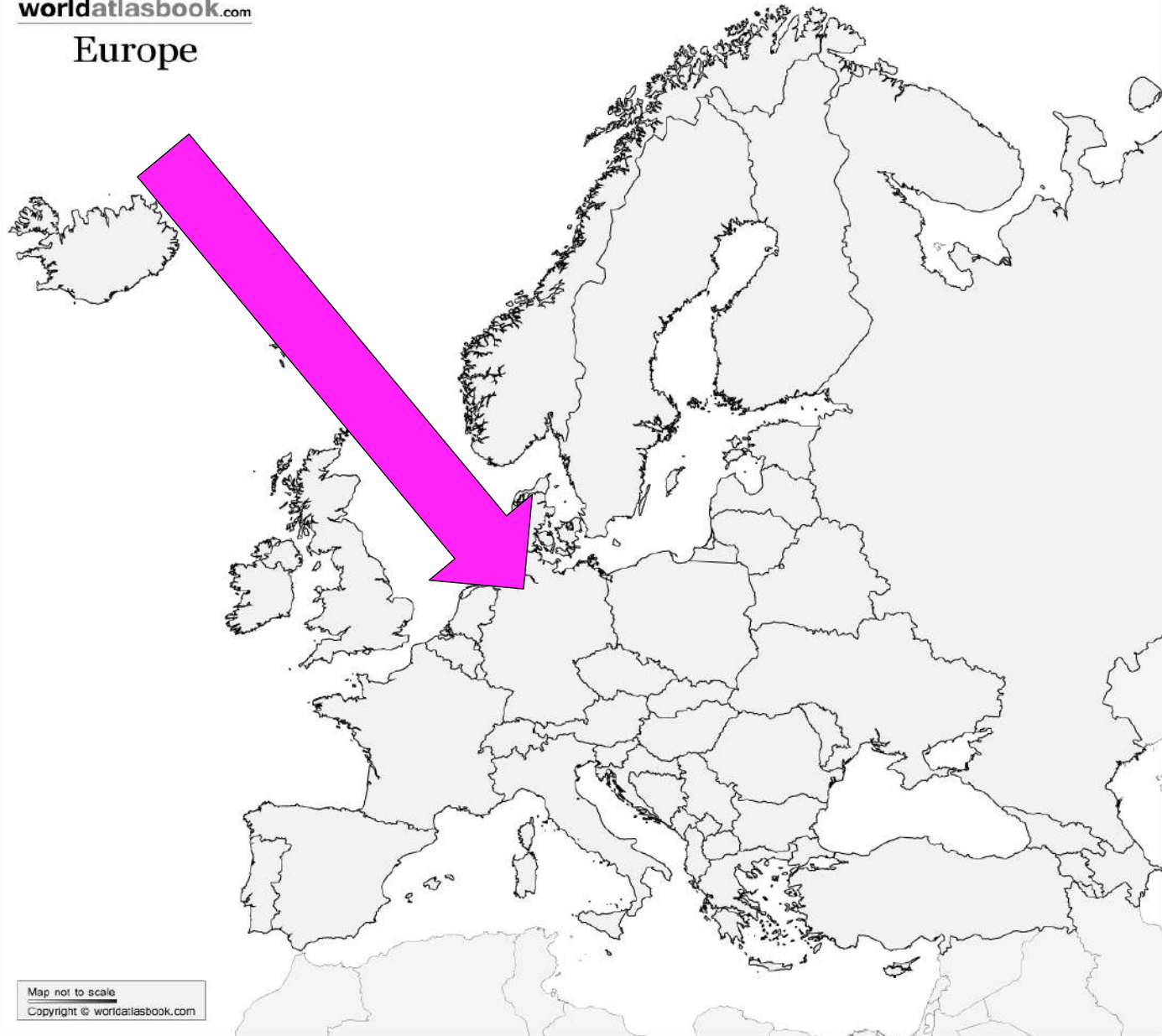

Location = Between Russia and Poland

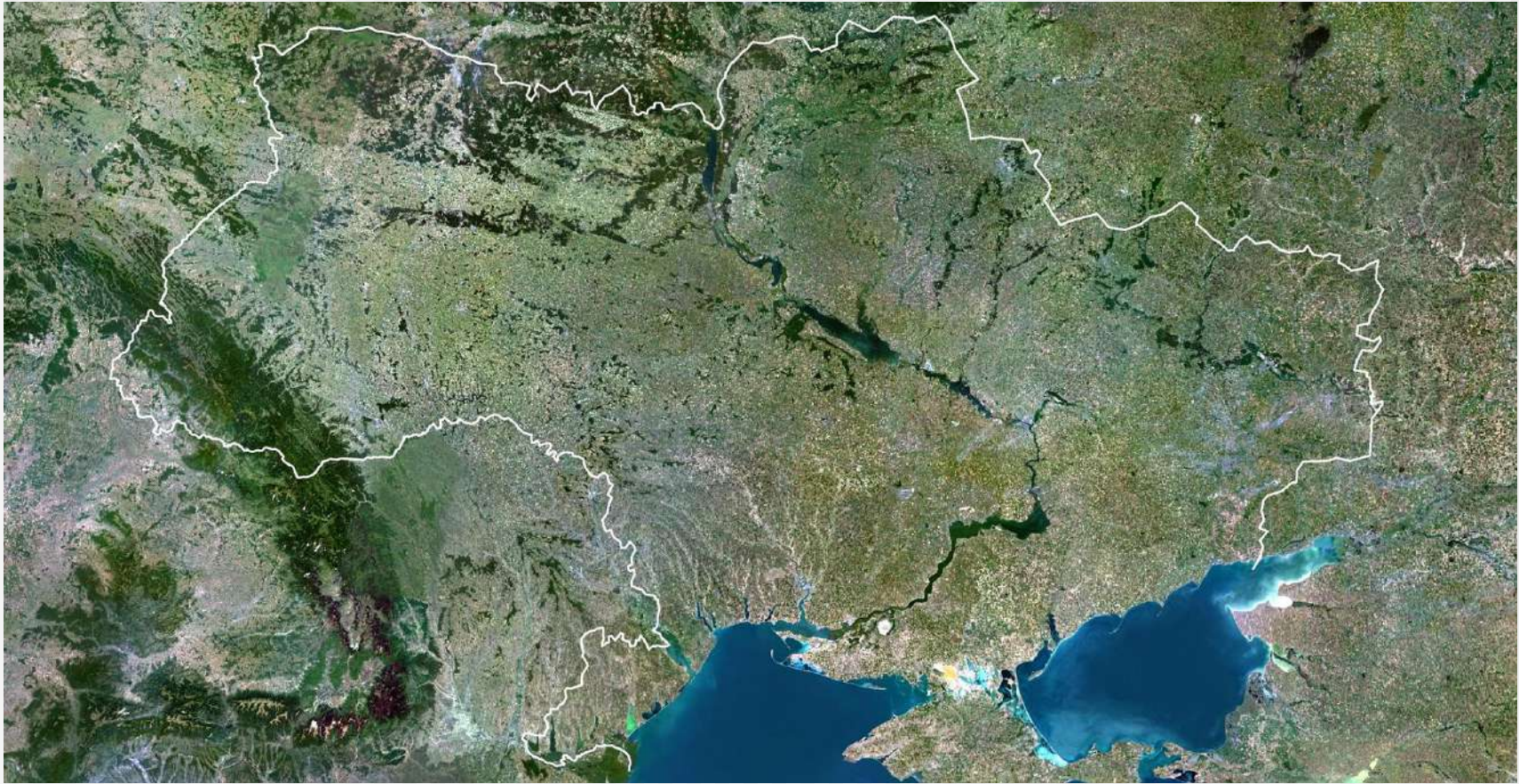
Capital = Kiev
