Stanley School is located in Stanley, Idaho, a beautiful, remote, and rural setting. We currently have 22 students enrolled in grades K-8.




Stanley School was built in 1978 and needs an upgrade! The Stanley School Parents' Association (SSPA) is partnering with the Challis School District to expand and remodel our school. A new library will allow us to move our library out of the boys' shower room. One new classroom will replace an aging portable, which lacks a toilet and running water. A second new classroom will provide space for high school education in Stanley, which would allow parents to consider long-term residency and would help retain local volunteers and employees for emergency and health services, law enforcement, and businesses. Additional funds raised will pay for improvements to the existing building for better safety and efficiency.
