## What is Indicator 13?







- Indicator 13 measures the percentage of students who are 16 years of age and older with an IEP
- This IEP must include appropriate transition assessment and transition services (including course of student) that will allow the student to meet those postsecondary goals
- The student must be invited to attend this IEP team meeting where transition is discussed

## Who does Indicator 13 apply to?

- Illinois school code requires that a student's IEP must contain a transition plan by the time the student is **14 ½ years of age**
- Please note, Fund Code L,P,N and U do not require a transition plan

## Adding a new Indicator 13 record...

- From the student search results grid, select the 13 next to the student that requires a new transition plan

- Yes: If items 1a. through 7q., 8s. And 8t. are ALL answered **Yes** AND 8r. is answered **No**, then the IEP meets Indicator 13 requirements.
- No: If one or more items were answered **No**, with the exception of 8r., then the IEP **does not meet** Indicator 13 requirements. (Out of compliance)

# Indicator 13 Errors vs. Warnings in I-Star

- Incomplete = Error



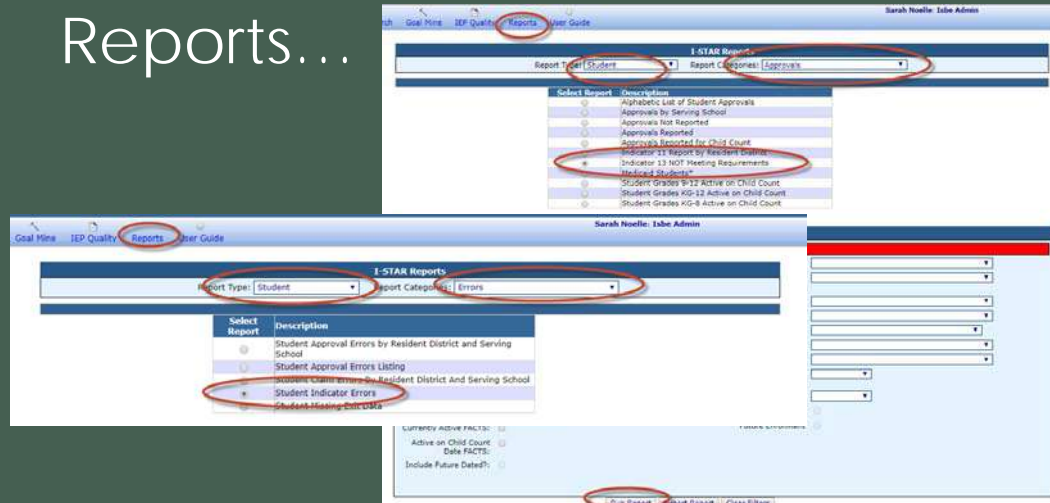
- No = Warning (Out of compliance)
