* Our two official State languages, 'Ōlelo Hawai'i and English; OR

* Either of our two state's languages, 'Ōlelo Hawai'i or English, and at least one other language.

Last year there were 19 class of 2023 graduates who successfully demonstrated their proficiency in two or more languages and who received this very special Seal of Biliteracy award.
