- Submission form must be completed, scanned and emailed to ed2010org@gmail.com no later than Monday, August 31, 2015. Once applications are received, an invitation to Dropbox will be generated so that photos and artist statements can be uploaded by school.
- Artwork image (picture) must be submitted via upload as a JPEG [no less than 300dpi] to Embracing Differences Dropbox (invitation only)
- Artwork image must be capable of being displayed <u>landscape</u> and must measure 12.8 inches wide by 8.8 inches high
- Artist(s) Statement(s) describing the artwork and inspiration must created in Microsoft Word
 and uploaded to your specific folder in Dropbox no later than Friday, September 11, with the
 limitations listed here:
 - o **High School (Grades 9-12)** should be no more than 100 words
 - o Middle School (Grades 6-8) should be no more than 75 words
 - o **Elementary School (Grades 1-5)** should be no more than 50 words
- All original artwork is due to Embracing Differences no later than Friday, September 11, 2015.

Guidelines:

- 1. Artwork may be the product of an individual or group.
- 2. All submissions, unless the student (parent) opts out, will be a part of the auction, a fundraiser supporting future events. Artwork sold at auction will result in 40% of the proceeds to the student, with the remaining 60% retained by Embracing Differences, Inc. for future events. If a group work is submitted and is sold, the 40% will be a check made payable to the school's art department. All submissions made available for auction and that are not sold are the property of Embracing Differences, Inc for future fundraising purposes.
- 3. Original artwork may be any size; however pictures of your artwork must meet the JPEG guidelines (no less than 300dpi and capable of being displayed as 12.8 inches wide by 8.8 inches high (must have landscape layout)). These dimensions will allow entries to be expanded for the purpose of displaying on banners (if needed).
- 4. A quote or artist statement describing the art work and inspiration is required.
- 5. There will be three winners in each category of school (elementary, middle, high) for a total of nine winners. Additionally, there will be three People's Choice winners selected via a Facebook Campaign winners will be awarded \$250 each. In the event that a group submission is selected for the People's Choice Award, a check will be made payable to the school to be used to celebrate the students taking part in the winning project.
