



CHAPTER 1

Addition and Subtraction Within 1,000

Lesson 1.10 Use Place Value to Subtract

This lesson works on subtracting with regrouping the "old way".

EX: 473-294

First estimate to check your answer.

My estimate is → 470

$$\begin{array}{r} -295 \\ 175 \end{array}$$

Now just line up your numbers, into ones, tens and hundreds columns. Then start with the ones place and begin subtracting, regrouping when necessary.

$$\begin{array}{r} 16 \\ 3 \cancel{1} 13 \\ 473 \\ - 294 \\ \hline 179 \end{array}$$

Another way to check your answer is to use addition to subtract. Using the same numbers in the equation above, make an addition sentence (related facts).

$$\begin{array}{r} 179 \\ +294 \\ \hline 473 \end{array}$$

The answer should be the number you subtracted from.
