

Program Explanation

The High School Summer Math Academy allows students to earn credit for the GSE Algebra I, GSE Geometry, GSE Algebra II, or GSE Pre-Calculus course they attempted and did not pass. This intense four- week program identifies areas that the student needs to remediate and a certified teacher provides a combination of direct instruction and online learning to help the student become skilled and show mastery of the content.

Who Can Attend

The program is open to high school students enrolled in Forsyth County Schools.

Dates and Times

Monday, June 4 – Thursday, June 28. Classes are held Monday – Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Location

Classes will be held at Forsyth Central High School, 131 Elm Street,, Cumming, GA 30040

Class Size

Average student teacher ratio is 18:1.

Registration Procedures and Dates

All registrations must be done at the student's base school by a counselor or designee. Counselors must complete an online registration form for each student. Registrations will be accepted from Monday, May 7th – Friday, June 1st.

Cost and Payment

Each course is \$300. Payment must be given at the time of registration and can be made by cash, check, or money order. Checks should be made payable to the student's base school. *No refunds will be given after the first day of class*.

Attendance

Students have a limited time to complete the coursework; therefore, daily attendance is critical and required. The Math Academy director has the authority to withdraw students for lack of attendance.

Grading Procedures

When a student fails and then retakes the same course, both courses and both grades are posted on the student transcript. Retaking and passing the course *does not* replace the failing grade.

Georgia Milestones End of Course (EOC)

EOCs for GSE Algebra I and GSE Geometry will be administered prior to the final day of class. Students must be in attendance to receive credit for the course

Behavior and Dress Code

Math Academy classes are conducted in a business-like environment. Students are expected to treat all staff and other students with respect and follow the FCS Student Code of Conduct and appropriate computer use. Students are expected to dress appropriately for a school setting. Failure to comply may result in removal from the Academy, solely at the discretion of the Director and cannot be appealed. NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.

School to Home Communication

Much of the communication from the school to home during the Math Academy will occur via email. This includes information prior to the start of the Academy, attendance information, and progress updates during the period of time that classes are being held. Please be sure to provide an email address during the registration process that is monitored daily.

Transportation / Drop Off and Pick Up Area / Parking

Students are responsible for their own transportation. Parents who provide transportation must drop off their child no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and must pick them up no later than 12:45 p.m.
