How do we do school?

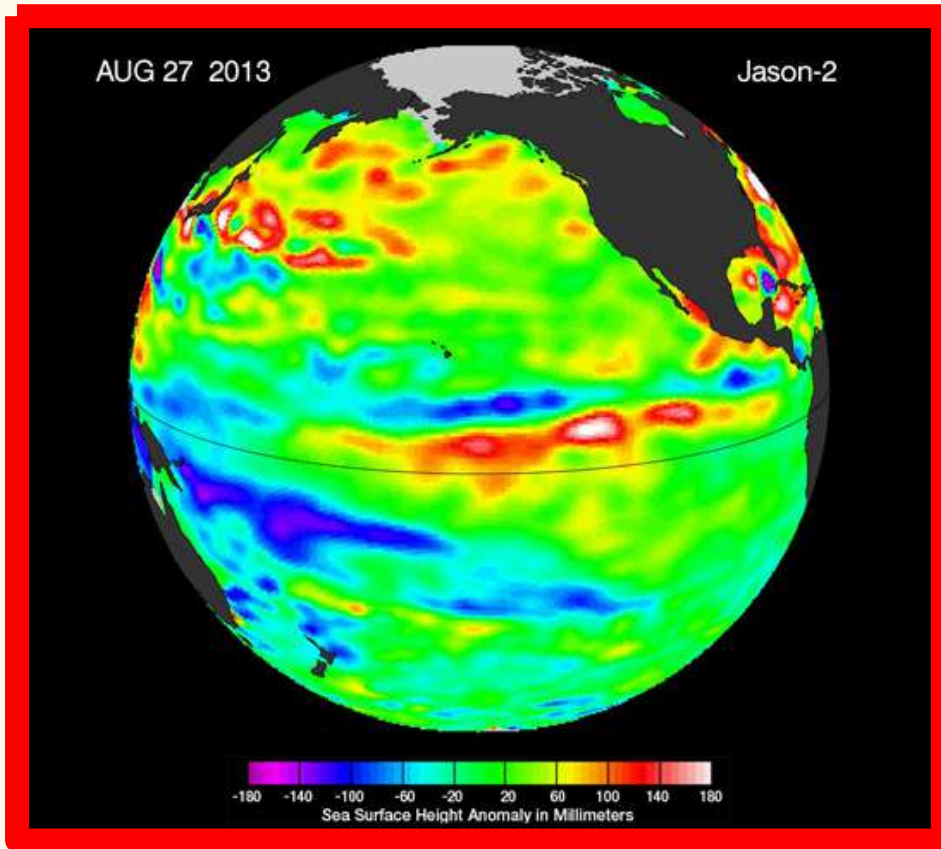
2 schools, in reality

Need to have conversations about, review and refine our culture and tone

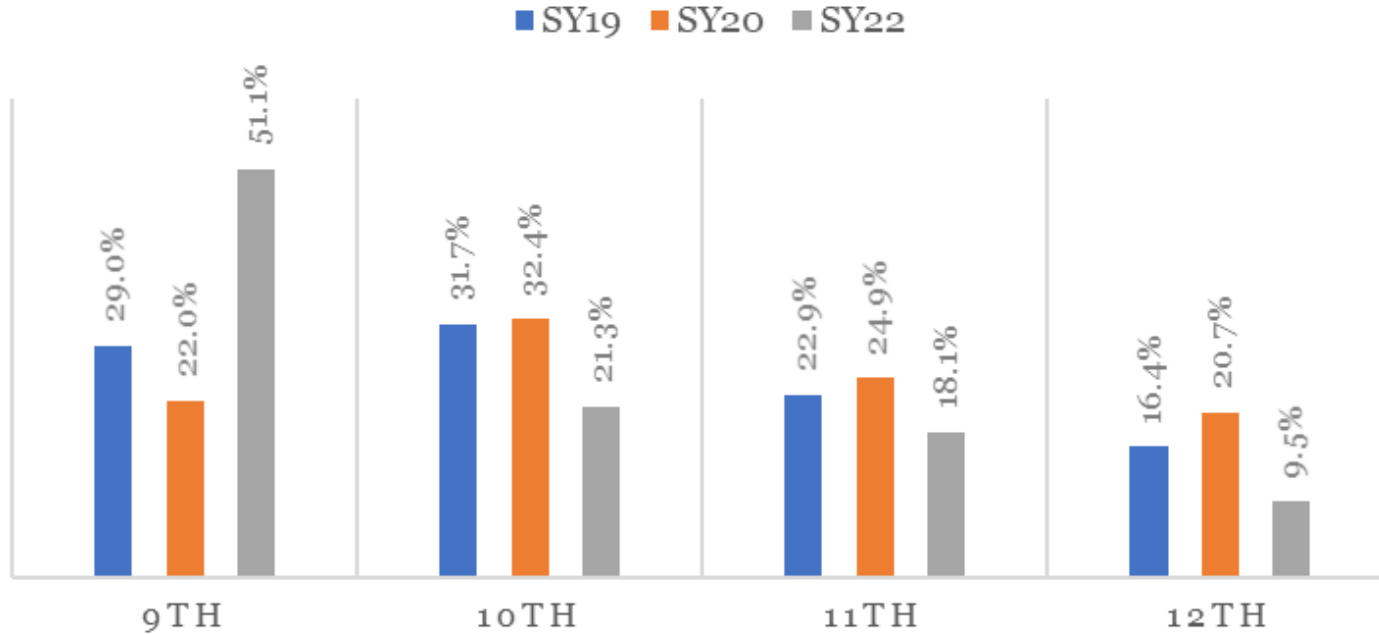

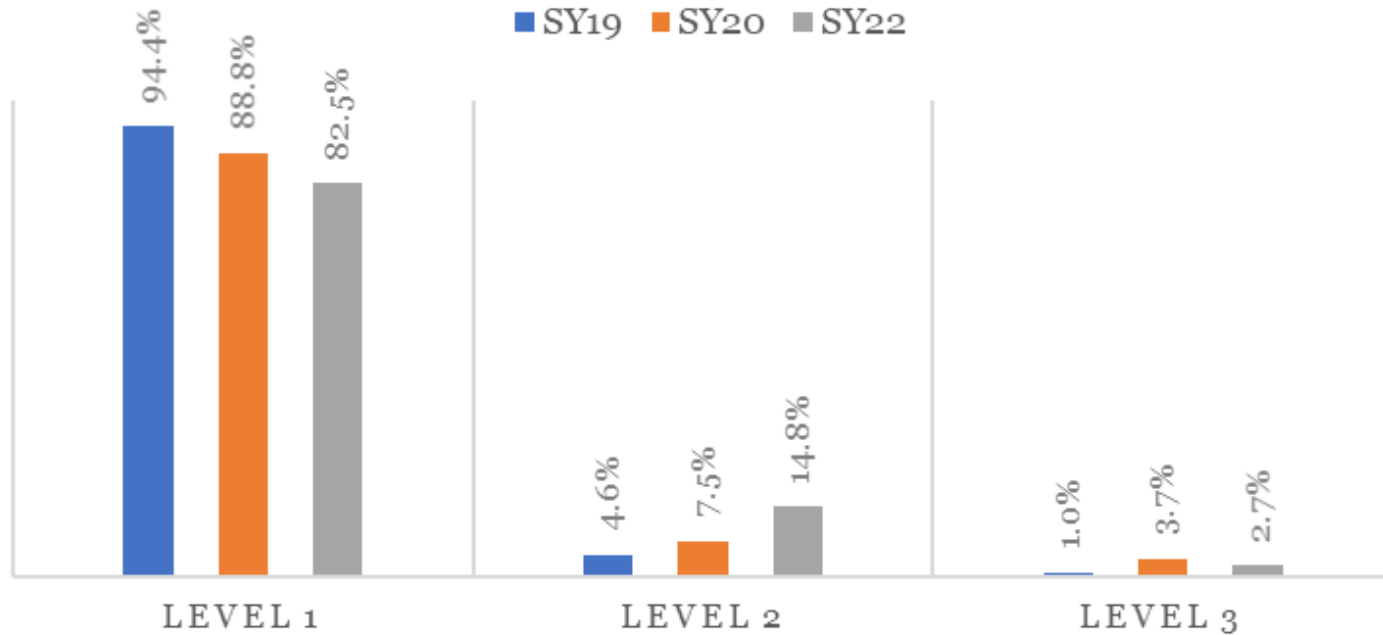

COMPARISONS - REFERRAL LEVEL



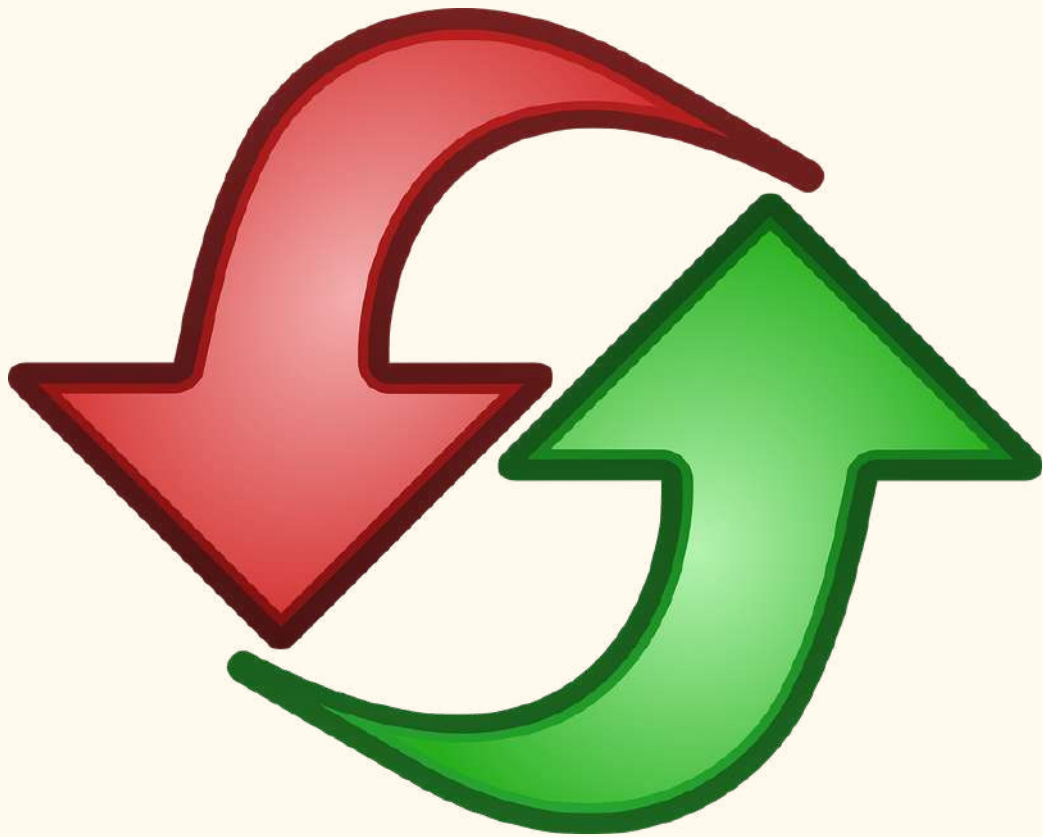
Disciplinary Referrals by grade levels: School Years 2022, 2020, 2019

Revisions and Plans to continue our forward progress...

- Begun the conversation: what school do we want to be? And, how do we get there?
- Shift homeroom to the 1st part of the day - then follow current 7 day or block daily schedules
 - Help with students who are on late-arriving buses.
 - Set a more consistent tone on getting to class on time.
- Revision of supervision procedures:
 - Transitions
 - Restrooms
 - Lunch
 - Re-mix teacher/class assignments
- Staged dismissal
- Administrative and support team periodically monitor hall traffic during various periods (hall passes, finding skippers)
- Proactive action with any possible reports of incitement
- Meeting schedule: M-Odd Block, TU-EVEN Blocks, W-Odd Blocks, TH-Even Blocks, F-All period day
- Continuing to evolve...

Planning for 2nd Semester

Continuing the conversation about: what school do we want to be? And, how do we get there?

Hosting meetings with 9th and 10 grade: expectations, academic assistance, emotional health support/Will host with 11th and 12th grade students in January

Additional personnel allocations
