Elements of Literature

## What is Setting?

- where and when a story takes place
- the *whole* environment in which the character lives
  - includes time
  - location
  - weather
  - physical setting
  - atmosphere



### Use your senses!

- Consider the five senses:
  - What do the characters see?
  - What do the characters hear?
  - Taste? Smell? Touch?



# Where do I find the setting in the text?

- Check the beginning primary setting information.
- Continue reading dialogue and events will reveal additional information.



# Purpose of Setting

- Setting the stage: background
- Critical to:
  - the development of the plot
  - to the understanding of the protagonist
  - or as a means of establishing the mood within the story.



### Social Environment

- What is the social environment of a story?
  - manners
  - customs
  - mores
  - rituals
  - codes of conduct
