AP Students and Parents/Guardians,

Good afternoon! You are receiving this e-mail because you/your child is registered for one or more AP test in the coming weeks. Exams are scheduled from Monday, May 2nd- Friday, May 13th.

Please be sure to read this email in its entirety, as it addresses important information about the upcoming test.

Locations:

Morning Exams:

- Report Time: No later than 7:15 am
- Report to the TCHS Cafeteria via the Bus Loop
- Lunch will be available immediately following exam.
- Extended time students and students taking two tests in a day should bring their lunch from home.

Afternoon Exams:

- Report Time: 11:30am
- Report to the TCHS Cafeteria via the Bus Loop
- Students may want to have a plan for transportation, incase an exam ends later than 3:50pm.
- End times for afternoon tests are unpredictable and may vary from day to day. Extended time exams will end later.
- Lunch will be available at 11:00 prior to the exam.

Two exams in a day:

You will need to bring a bag lunch. You will have an opportunity to eat (quickly, \sim 15 minutes) in a designated area between exams. You might also consider bringing a "snack lunch" that you can space out and eat during the exam breaks and the break between tests.

All Exams:

- Please be ready to go when you arrive! Pencils sharpened, stopped at the restroom, etc. Check the list of what to bring/not bring below. We will begin promptly!
- Students <u>cannot be dismissed early</u>. All test takers must remain until all tests are collected and counted.
- <u>Students should bring with them only what is necessary for exams</u>. Items not required for exam will be stored in a bin until exams are complete.

■ What to Bring:

- Several sharpened No. 2 Pencils with erasers (not mechanical pencils)
- Pens (dark blue or black ink only)
- Calculator (Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Statistics, Physics only) <u>be sure</u> yours meets the requirements. Calculators will be available if you do not have your own.
- Photo ID (if you are not a TCHS student)

- Layers of clothing (The climate could fluctuate between hot and cold so be prepared.)
- Water/small snack in a gallon Ziploc labeled with your name.
- Bagged lunch if you have two exams in the same day, or if you have a morning extended time test. You might consider bringing a "snack lunch" that you can eat throughout the day if you are taking multiple tests.

What NOT to Bring:

- Backpack/Large Bag if at all avoidable.
- Test Prep Books/Class Notes/Textbooks/etc These cannot enter the test room at all. Leave them home.
- Cell Phones/Smartwatches The official College Board policy is no phones in the testing room. Any cell phones, etc. that make it to the testing room will be turned off, collected, and returned to you after all exams have been collected. If you do not want us to take it, don't bring it at all.
- Mechanical Pencils
- Anything that makes noise
- Anything that covers your head (hoodie, hat)

The College Board requires that all students accept the terms and conditions. You will be asked for confirmation of your agreement to these terms as part of your test on exam day. These should have been reviewed in your classroom with your instructor.

AP Exam Terms and Conditions

Sending Scores

Beginning on April 11, the AP Classroom will prompt you to select where to send your scores. You can bypass that prompt by clicking the link "I don't want to send my scores".

Only Seniors should send official scores.

Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors should not send their scores at this time. You will report unofficial scores on college applications and send your official scores at the end of your senior year.

Score Release

Scores will be available in July 2022. Scores are released online.
