QUARTERLY BREAKDOWN WITH MAJOR TOPICS COVERED

QI Computational Thinking, Algorithms, Iterative Model, Programming Languages, Block Code — Scratch, Computer Limitations/Benefits, How Computers Work, Logical Thinking, Flowcharts, Pseudocode, Binary System, ASCII, Variables, Structure Conditions.

Q2 Computer Program Design, Programming Errors, Computational Concepts (sequence, loops, events, conditionals, operators, data), Computational Practices (experimenting and iterating, testing and debugging, reusing and remixing, abstracting and modularizing).

Q3 Technical Research, Security and Privacy Issues, Negative Impacts of Technology, Ethical Responsibilities, Job Search, Defining, Develop, & Present Self-Directed Project, Peer Collaboration, Feedback, Design Review, Resolve Conflicts.

Q4 Write text-based Python programs, Python and Console Interaction, Conditionals (If Statements, Boolean Values, Logical Operators, Comparison Operators), Looping (While Loops, For Loops, Break and Continue, Nested), Functions and Exceptions, Strings, Creating and Altering Data Structures.

HOMEWORK

GRADING

Monitoring your child's progress

Grades are posted online; parents have access to grades through the <u>Home Access</u> <u>Center (HAC)</u>

Grades are updates on a weekly basis.

The due date for an assignment is one week from it's posted date. If an assignment shows a grade of an INC on HAC students may submit/resubmit for a better grade.

Notifications for late submission will be posted on Schoology. If students do not submit by the late submission date the INC grade will turn into a 0. A zero indicates students missed several opportunities to hand in missed work and/or no effort was taken to correct an incomplete assignment.

GRADING (cont)

Grading Policy

Grades are divided into 2 categories, formative & summative assessments.

Formative 30% Formative Assessments consist of classroom assignments & quizzes

Summative 70% Summative Assessments consist of test and major projects

If you receive a summative grade, lower than 85%, you have the opportunity for a test retake.

Students have one chance to retake within two weeks of the test date to receive a maximum score of 85%.

LATE POLICY

- Deadlines for all missing work.
 - Notification of dates for late submissions will be posted on Schoology
 - HAC will be updated with students' latest submission grade.
