ABOUT ME (Coach Wilson)

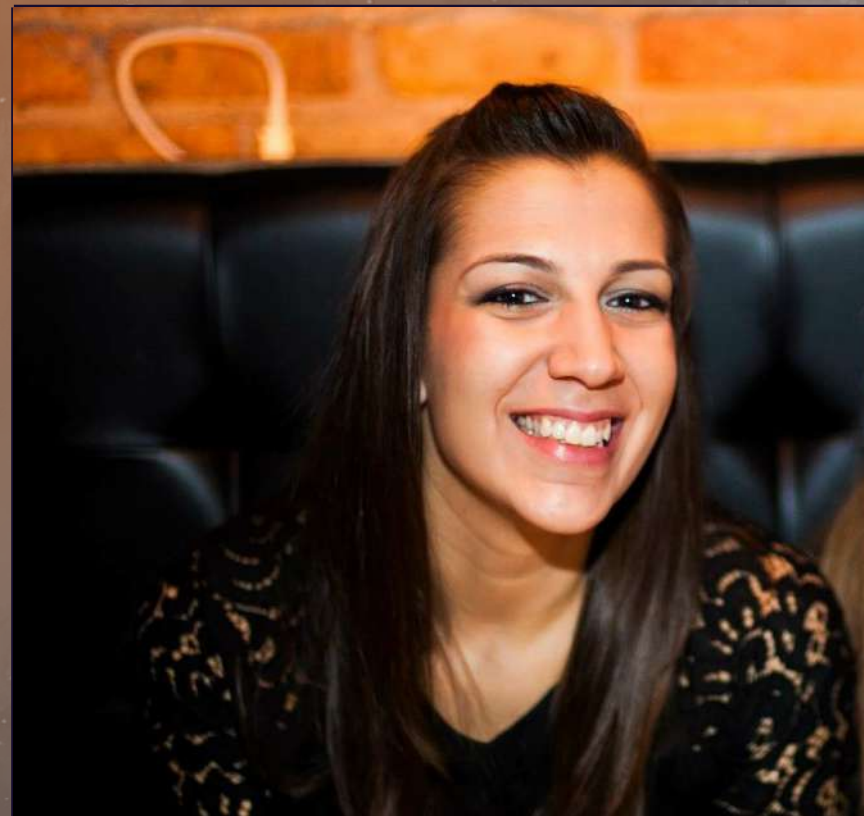
