

Co-Op -AT A GLANCE

Students are earning school credit for work there are doing outside of school in the community. Students must turn in documentation (monthly) showing that they have worked 5 hours per week for each period of Co-Op they are enrolled in.

To be marked PRESENT, your child simply has to initial the sign-in /out sheet at the front office daily.



GRADING

- Students earn a weekly formative grade for signing in/out on the sign-in sheet. If students are absent from all of their classes that day, they will not be penalized for not signing in/out. However, if they are in school that day and forget to sign out, they will lose points.
- Students earn a monthly summative grade, which consists of two parts.
 - Part one is the supervisor evaluation form. This can be found in schoology or hard copies are available in my office.
 - The other part is an official timecard or paystubs verifying that the required hours have been met for the month.
 - These are both due on the last Wednesday of each month.
