Your assignment: <u>Create a power point</u>, of topics from World History that start with each letter of the alphabet. You can pick people, events, items, acts, etc. from any time period. (Ex. world history in general, the Egyptians, Roman Empire, Age of Exploration, WWI. or WWII, what ever interests you.) Tell the historical significates of the topic. Do not use countries, they are not world history. Do not use U.S. History people or events. If you use a country, sports person or a U.S. item slide, you will not receive credit for that slide. Used the Rubric is on the back of this sheet to achieve maximum points. This project will be worth 2 test grades.

For each letter, you must:

- 1. Write the letter and what you used as an example at the top of the page ("A is for...") (Size 48 Font)
- 2. Include a picture or illustration for each letter.
- 3. Write 2-3 sentences explaining the example and how it was important to World History. (Size 28 Font)
