### SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

Applications for the summer Marine Science Program will be passed out by science teachers at all schools during the week of February 12<sup>th</sup>. Applications will be due back to science teachers by March 5<sup>th</sup>. This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven. Three eight day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School with bus transportation provided. The dates for the three sessions this summer will be May 29<sup>st</sup> through June 7<sup>th</sup>, June 11<sup>th</sup> through June 21<sup>st</sup>, and June 25<sup>th</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>. Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments.
