

When setting up an account you will select "https://scps.instructure.com/register".





YYYYMMDD






Adding Additional Students to a Parent (Observer) account





Click on Account, and then Profile






Click on Observing -> enter the Username of the next student you want to account your account and their password -> + Student






Access Student Courses

You will be able to view all of the course content, but they will not have the ability to interact with the course, such as responding to a discussion board.



Parents are able to view individual grades for a course by clicking the Grades link in the course navigation, if the teacher has enabled it.


