## **General Information and Grant Guidelines**

THE PLAYERS Championship is offering student leadership grants through CHARACTER COUNTS! of St. Johns County for the expansion and enhancement of character education within the St. Johns County School District through projects, programs, and new or existing clubs.

### WHO CAN APPLY?

- Schools
- Individual teachers
- Administration

### **USE OF FUNDS**

Funds may be used for, but not limited to, professional development/training, support materials, retreats, guest speakers, community and school activities, apparel for club/project/program.

#### **DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS AND EXPENDITURES**

Applications will be accepted throughout the school year and reviewed by the committee within two weeks of date received. Applicants will be notified directly by a committee representative.

**Evaluation:** A final end-of-year outcome and expenditure report is required at the completion of the club/program/project. To be eligible to participate in future funding opportunities, timely submissions of the evaluation is required.

- END-OF-YEAR PROJECT OUTCOME AND EXPENDITURE REPORT: Due May 21, 2019 detailing:
  - Project goals and outcomes- did the club/project/program meet the goals and outcomes outlined in the application? Explain

  - Please provide photos, flash drives, websites, PowerPoints, videos or short anecdotes of the project in action that can be used by the CHARACTER COUNTS! Steering Committee and The Players for program evaluations and publicity. Please invite St. Johns County School District Community Relations Department to see the club/program/project in action!

Application -includes cover page, narrative, goals/outcome and itemized budget

<u>Project Narrative/ Details of Project</u> – Provide a brief description/summary of the purpose of this club/program/ project and list ways that it will benefit the school/community.

<u>Project Outcome Paragraph and Method of Evaluation-</u> Explain how your program/project will impact students as well as promote good character. How will students grow in their leadership abilities through this project/program? How will it be evaluated? What evaluation tool(s) will be used?

- o Include total amount and costs of individual items needed for implementation of project
- List alternative funds/resources that may be used to implement this project (Community/business partners)
- The following items will not be considered for allowable expenditures:

(a) It contains obscene material or is inappropriate for family viewing in a school environment;

(b) It promotes products that are unlawful for minors to purchase or use, or businesses that are unlawful for minors to patronize;

(c) It is political or proselytizing;

(d) It would be inconsistent with School District policies or contrary to law; or

(e) It would tend to disrupt the school environment.
