This past week in RamNation, we held our ACT School Day for all juniors, and a few weeks ago, we held our PSAT/SAT School Day for all students. Students who are on an IEP, a 504, or who are English Language Learners typically qualify for accommodations for College Board testing, but those accommodations are not automatic. Parents must sign a consent form, and then students submit the form to their school counselor in Student Services. If you believe your child should be receiving accommodations for College Board testing but that hasn't happened, please email your child's counselor to get the form. At the end of this week, we will be administering the Florida Civics Literacy Exam to all seniors. This testing requirement is written into Florida State Statute. To read a Fact Sheet about this exam, click here. Students who pass this exam will have met the civics literacy requirement for all students who earn either an Associate's degree or Bachelor's degree in a Florida State College or University. When students get to college, they have to pay to take this exam, so a little preparation now could save seniors money later, Links to prep materials can be found on the right. ### Florida Civics Literacy Exam for Seniors

- The FCLE will be given to all seniors at the end of this week. Students taking AP Government will take the test on Thursday during 1st and 2nd periods. All other seniors will take it on Friday during either 1st and 2nd or 5th and 6th. Students should check their school email on Clever to find testing times and locations.
- The FCLE contains 80 multiple-choice items and is administered in one 160-minute session in one day. Students who have not completed the test in 160 minutes may continue working up to half a typical school day.

### Attention Current or Prospective Dual Enrollment Students

For students interested in Dual Enrollment (DE) through Seminole State College (SSC) please visit <u>SSC DE Webpage</u>. Then follow "Steps to Apply" SSC Dual Enrollment and Early College or on the Seminole County Public Schools (SCPS) webpage by clicking on the link for <u>Dual</u> Enrollment and Early Admissions Procedures.

Please note: Counselors will only sign completed, Dual Enrollment applications then give the forms back to the student or parent to submit to the SSC DE office. Starting November 1, 2022, application and registration forms for individual students will no longer be accepted via email (dual enrollment or Tiffany Kilpatrick's personal email Inbox). Instead, students must submit forms in person to one of <u>SSC's Success Specialists</u>.

Applications are only required once per high school tenure unless you have not registered for classes for at least three consecutive semesters or are applying to Early College with SSC. If you do not enroll in DE courses for three consecutive semesters at SCC, you must submit another application. Once the application is completed, the student must follow the steps to complete the registration process on the <u>SCPS Dual</u> Enrollment and Early Admissions Webpage.

For the Spring Semester, DE students course registration approvals must be obtained by having the high school counselor sign the registration card. The DE APP located in Clever will not be used at this time. LMHS is requiring all DE students to submit their registration forms for counselor approval and signature by November 18. This way students can submit their registration forms by December 1 to SCC to complete the registration process.

# Testing Update

### **SAT School Day Results (12th Grade)**

Results for the SAT School Day taken on October 12 are now available online in the student College Board account. Students can call College Board at 888-225-5427 if they are not able to log into their account. The results should be in Skyward soon.

### **Advanced Placement Exams**

Students who are currently enrolled in an Advanced Placement course must register for the exam through a College Board online process. All students are required to take the AP exam for the AP courses in which they are enrolled. If students have not yet signed up for AP Classroom (for the exam order), please contact their teacher for the course Join Code. Students can call College Board at 888-225-5427 if they have any issues logging into their College Board account to complete this exam order process. The exam order deadline is November 15.

### **Scholar's Diploma EOC Testing**

EOC testing for students who are pursuing a Scholars Diploma or who have not taken the EOC in the past and have an NG grade on their transcript will be on November 28, 29, 30 and December 2 or 4 in Media at 7:20am.
