You must provide two text evidence to support your claim/answer to the question. Be sure to cite textual evidence in your response using proper MLA format; (last name page #). Use the IRACES method: **I**ndent your paragraph, **R**estate the question, **A**nsWER the question, **C**ite textual evidence (**X2**), **E**xplain/analyze textual evidence (**X2**), and **S**ummarize/wrap-up your response. Your response should be in the following order: IRA(CECE)S.

Turn in final draft to Google Classroom by December 15th by the end of the class period.
