Note: Clicking on the link above takes you to the LMS and the screen below.




The left of your screen shows all your courses. Please contact the school counselor if a course is wrong or missing.

 -the **ACTUAL GRADE** is your current grade in the course


Note: You complete the course by doing all the pages until the course ends. You never need to worry about what to do next, just click on the Next Activity arrow.
