## **HOW do we Learn in World History?**

Whether you are a brick and mortar student or a distance learner, our class participates in a method of instruction called "flipped learning". Most direct instruction takes place at home in the form of 10-20-minute videos. In class time is reserved for review, remediation, working in small groups, and diving deeper into our curriculum. Students are expected to watch the videos two to three times a week, then take notes in a packet provided in class and is available to print from home for distance learning. After watching the video, students will take a five-question assessment on Schoology about the video notes. If your student does not have Internet or printer access at home, please let me know as soon as possible.
