Algebra I



Clinic News

If your child or family member tests positive for COVID, please keep your student at home and notify the school health technician of the test result at <u>cheryl.stewart@clayton.k12.ga.us</u>. If you suspect your child has been exposed to COVID or you are awaiting test results, please keep your student at home and report it to the health technician.

Attention new enrollees and 11th-grade students: Effective for the 2021-2022 School Year, all students entering or transferring into the 11th grade will need proof of the meningococcal booster shot (MCV4) unless their first dose was received on or after their 16th birthday. These immunization records are due immediately. You must comply with this mandate as your child will not remain enrolled in school if these records are not provided. Are you new to the county and do not have a healthcare provider? No Problem! All vaccines can be updated by appointment at the Clayton County Board of Health, 1117 Battlecreek Rd. Jonesboro, GA 30236 (678-610-7199).

Attendance

Parents, attendance is vital to the success of your student. If your student will be absent for any reason, please notify the attendance clerk at **kesha.davis@clayton.k12.ga.us** or call **678-817-300 extension: 311135**. Your student can turn in doctors' notes and parent letters to the attendance window before the first bell or during their lunchtime to maximize instructional time. Students will not be permitted to leave the class to turn in attendance notes since there are alternative times for them to do so.

Dress Code:

As we continue our efforts to pursue an environment of excellence in all matters pertaining to MMHS, it is essential that your child is not in violation of the CCPS dress code policies. Clothing such as ripped jeans exposing the upper thighs, biker shorts, leggings, and see-through garments are all unacceptable attire. New Students/Parents:

CCPS requires that all families provide documentation when they enroll in our schools. Proof of residency includes a lease/mortgage or utility bill. A complete list of the required documentation for enrollment can be found <u>here</u>.

ADAP and Certificate of Enrollment:

The Certificate of Enrollment should be requested at least 24 hours before your DMV appointment. We encourage all parents to secure their test date prior to ordering a Certificate of Enrollment since these forms do expire and require a notary seal (provided by the school). Please be advised that the only Advanced Placement (AP) courses exempt from taking the GMAS this school year is AP U.S. History. All other AP courses, AP American Literature and AP Biology will be required to take the GMAS unless the student already has a passing American Literature or Biology grade(s) posted to their transcript.

Important Notes

All students enrolled in a GMAS course must test.

GMAS counts for 20% of the student's final grade.

Students will receive an "Incomplete" until the GMAS is taken.

School Based Vaccination Clinic

Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS), through collaborative efforts between the CCPS Department of Student Services and the Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services, will offer onsite COVID-19 vaccinations for eligible students at select school sites **beginning Tuesday**, **September 21**, **2021**. The vaccine will be available for CCPS students during the school day. Students must be 12 years of age or older to be vaccinated. Students who are 12 to 17 years of age must have parental/guardian consent. Students who are 18 years of age and older may self consent to receive the vaccine.

In addition, CCPS will launch school-based COVID-19 testing sites at all schools beginning on **Monday**, **September 20**, **2021**. Available for all staff and students daily, participation in COVID-19 testing is optional and each school testing site will use the Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Test. The scheduled dates for MMHS is as follows:


