## EXAM EXEMPTIONS – High School

Clayton County Public Schools permits the following exam exemptions in the **first semester (Term 2-winter)** and second semester (**Term 4-spring**) for all grade levels following the guidelines below:

1. Students **passing a course that does not require an End of Course (EOC)** test shall have the option of exempting a class examination.
2. Students with **no office referral and a passing grade** in the class shall have the option of exempting a class examination.
3. Students who earned an **average grade of “A”** for the **first semester (Term 2-winter)** or second semester (**Term 4 - spring**) grade in the class shall have the option of exempting a class examination.
4. Students with **perfect attendance** for the year and a **passing grade** in the class shall have the option of exempting a class examination.

Number of exemptions allowed by grade level:

### (Yearlong Courses)

Number of exemptions allowed by grade level:

### (Semester-long Courses)

- 9<sup>th</sup> grade – 2 exam exemptions
- 10<sup>th</sup> grade – 3 exam exemptions
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade – 4 exam exemptions
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade – all exams may be exempted
- 9<sup>th</sup> grade – 1 exam exemption
- 10<sup>th</sup> grade – 1 exam exemption
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade – 2 exam exemptions
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade – all exams may be exempted

In addition, seniors who have **not** met obligations are **not allowed** to exempt any final exams and may not participate in graduation activities. Obligations include but are not limited to lost or damaged textbooks, calculators, or library materials, fees not paid, and uniforms not returned.

## Definitions and Explanations

Consideration for exam exemption shall be on a class-by-class basis. The definition of perfect attendance in a class is defined as:

- No Absences
- No late check-in
- No early check-out

There are no exceptions granted for any reason, no matter how critically important the reason. A **first-semester (Term 2-winter)** or second-semester (**Term 4 – spring**) senior who meets the criteria for exemption but chooses to take the semester examination is worthy of commendation. If that student’s examination grade increases his/her final grade, the examination shall be counted. If, however, that student’s examination grade lowers the final average, the examination grade shall not be counted.



# Testing at "The Mill"

## Georgia Milestones (GMAS)

GMAS testing begins Monday, December 6, and ends Friday, December 17, 2021, here at Mundy's Mill High School.

- ◇ All testing will be face-to-face. Therefore, **virtual students** enrolled in a GMAS course will be required to return to the building to test.
- ◇ Students enrolled in the following content courses during the fall semester WILL be required to test:

**American Literature**

**Algebra I**

**Biology**

**U.S. History**

Please be advised that the only Advanced Placement (AP) course exempt from taking the GMAS this school year is AP U.S. History. All other AP courses, AP American Literature and AP Biology will be required to take the GMAS unless the student already has a passing American Literature or Biology grade(s) posted to their transcript.

### Important Notes

All students enrolled in a GMAS course must test.

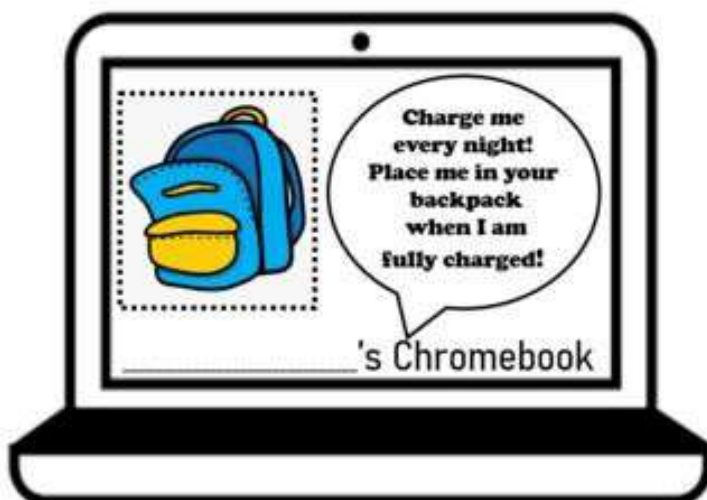
GMAS counts for 20% of the student's final grade.
