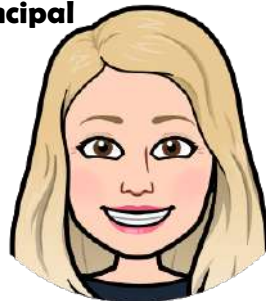

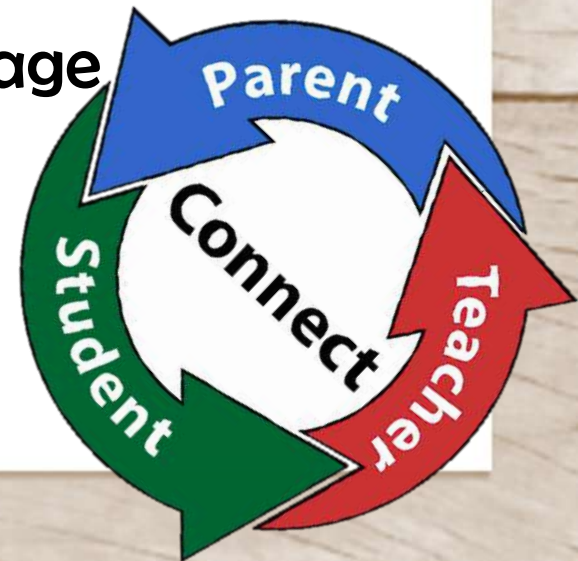

 - If you need access or would like to set up your Parent Portal Account, you can call the front office for more information.



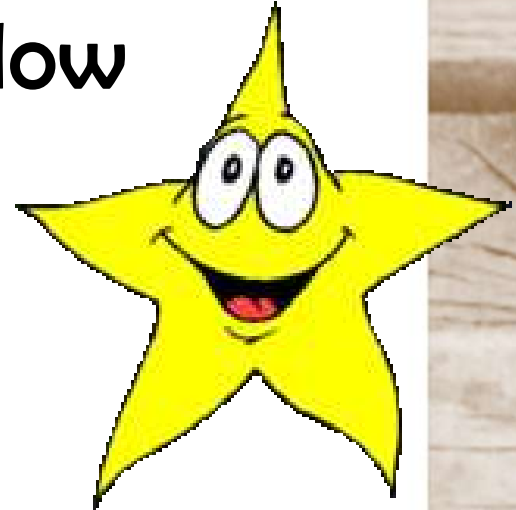
L4GA Grant & Do the Math

- **L4GA** – (Year 3) Literacy Grant that allows us to focus on the instruction of reading through multiple forms.
 - Shared Reading
 - Interactive Read Alouds
 - Differentiated Instructional Groups
 - iRead (Software Based Program)
 - System 44 (Software Based Program)
 - Read 180 (Software Based Program)
- **Do the Math** – Differentiated Instructional Math Program that allows teachers to help students grow through Math practice.

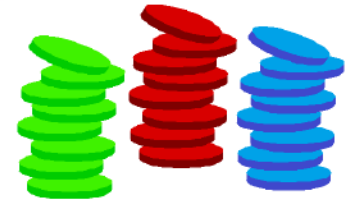




- When school employees “catch” a student demonstrating school expectations, they may be awarded a fish.

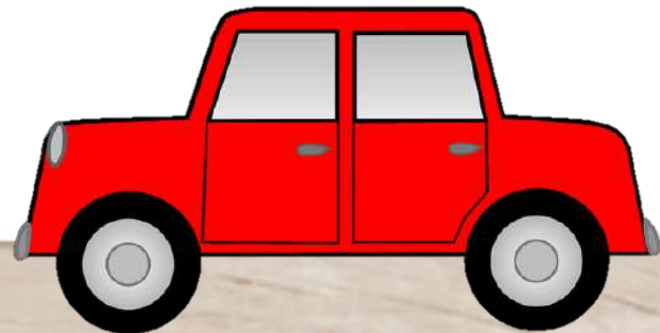

- Mask/ Cleaning/ Social Distancing



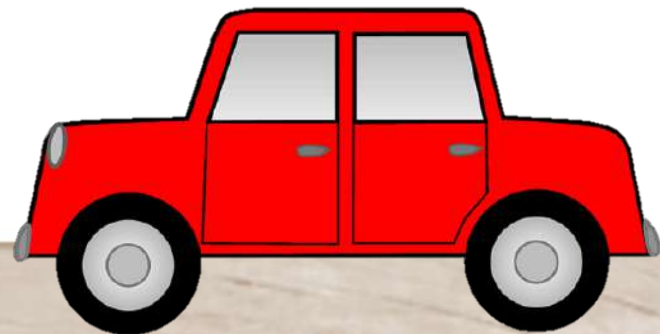
Car Rider & Dismissal
