- 4. What do the people wear? Do they have a national dress?
- 5. What do the houses look like?
- 6. What is the terrain mountains, water, desert, forest, beaches, ...
- 7. What plant life, flowers and trees are in the country?
- 8. What is the country's language?
- 9. Do the people have music or dance that is special to their country? Does your country host an annual festival (Jazz festival, arts festival, movie festival, etc.)
- 10. List several places a visitor to the country would want to visit and see.

Assignment 2:

Design a travel poster for your country.

Steps:

- 1. Select an image that you think best represents your country or describes something special about the country. (examples: shoreline, rain forest, dance or music, scenery, unusual animal/bird/..., special costume or dress, special event, historical, special holiday, place)
- 2. Lightly draw the image in the center of the paper...large, fill the space.
- 3. Use water color wash and blending to add the base colors.
- 4. Use markers and colored pencils to add details to the image.
- 5. Neatly cut large letters to paste the name of the country on your poster from colored construction paper.
- 6. Plan the best place for the name of the country and glue down.
