- Tryouts will be held on Thursday, March 31, beginning at 4:30 in the North Middle gym. The results will be posted on the school web site by Friday night.
- All participants must wear a **plain white shirt and plain red shorts** on Thursday for judging.

The squads will be chosen based on the outcome of overall scores on the final day of tryouts.

- The Competition Squad is made up of both 7th and 8th graders and will cheer for both football games and competitions
- 7th Grade Basketball Squad 7th graders only (may also be a competition cheerleader)
- 8th Grade Basketball Squad 8th graders only (may also be a competition cheerleader)

Requirements:

- YOU MUST HAVE A CURRENT PHYSICAL ON FILE WITH UPDATED INSURANCE INFORMATION—Physicals need to be on a specific Forsyth County form, please see Coach Hoyle or the athletics page of our website for the proper form.
- You must have passed 5 classes for the <u>first semester</u> this year. Grades will be checked again at the end of the year and eligibility requirements must be met to remain on the squad.
- Attendance records will be checked and any child that has excessive absences will not be considered for any squad.
- Competition cheerleaders must be able to attend summer clinics and camps, a <u>mandatory choreography clinic is scheduled for the week</u> of June 23-25 (not a requirement for the basketball squads).
- Both participants and parents must understand the time involved in competition cheerleading: summer clinics, after school practice, football games and competitions. Due to competition schedules we may have extra practices during the week.
- Summer Dates (competition squad only):
 - June- 14, 15, 16 and 22, 23, 24, 25 (Twisters)
 - July 11, 12, 13, and 14 (Twisters)
 - July 26, 27, 28 (NFMS)

The following is what coaches and judges will be looking for:

- Positive Attitude
- Good Attendance Record
- Grades (remember you are **student athletes**)
- Jumps (Toe Touch, Pike, Hurdler)
- Dance (facials, timing, coordination and precise motions)
- Cheer Spirit, Voice Projection and Motions solid arm movements (sharp and precise)
- Tumbling Ability Competition Squad Only (standing back handspring, round off back handspring, tuck, etc...)
- Tumbling will not be considered when choosing the basketball squads

A <u>MANDATORY</u> parent meeting and uniform fitting will be held on Wednesday, April 27, for those who make the competition squad.

- Approximate cost for the Competition Squad \$1,000 this will be broken down into two installments.
 - ➤ This includes choreography, music, uniform, practice clothes & shoes, gym fees
- Payment dates:
 - April 8 \$50 Booster Club payment is due
 - > April 29 1st installment due
 - ➤ May 27 2nd installment due
 - ✓ There will be fund-raisers to help with your costs
 - ✓ All cheerleaders must participate in all fund-raisers
